TIM PETROVIC (-8)

Q. What did you think out there today?

TIM PETROVIC: I wasn't doing much thinking, I was just -- I knew it was going to be tough, it was going to be windy. The wind actually started picking up more as the round went on and you just had to try to kind of hunker down and make the putts inside of five feet that you needed to make. I made all those. I made one bogey today, but I drove it really well and just gave myself a lot of chances on the greens. Just needed to get the putter in my hand so I could get a lot of opportunities. I hit it a little closer than I did -- I didn't really make any putts the first two days, kind of got behind the eight-ball, but it was nice to see some go in today.

Q. Overall three days body of work, how would you assess how you've done?

TIM PETROVIC: I gave myself a C the first day, I gave myself a B, I gave myself an A today. Just a little bit better every day. I think I managed better, my thought process was a little bit better. I said this at the PGA, if I could play better, you know, it's hard to try less, try not to try, but it's hard to get in that zone and I got in that zone today, so it was nice.

Q. First visit to Sioux Falls and this golf course, how would you review that?

TIM PETROVIC: I can't believe how well, with the amount of rain we got Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, how well the golf course did getting rid of all the water. I heard they flew helicopters over the golf course to try to dry the fairways out, but they did a fantastic job. The course is in such good shape now, you wouldn't have known we had three days of rain.
