Q. First of all, how was the golf out there today versus the first two days?

KIRK TRIPLETT: It was almost the same as yesterday, same conditions. Pins weren't quite as severe, I didn't think, today. You had to play good, there's a lot of tough shots. There's plenty of birdie holes if you can kind of hang in there until the last four or five holes.

Q. How about with Stricker, seems like when he comes out here, he's pretty aggressive?

KIRK TRIPLETT: He's just really good. He's still competitive on the regular tour. I don't think any of us are under any illusion out here about how our skill level compares to the regular tour. We play golf fine on our courses, but a guy like that, he drives the ball in the fairway and putts really, really well. Those are the two things that are really demanded out here.

Q. You're familiar with the community here, I would guess, more so than a lot of the golfers who have been here before. Was this an event you were kind of looking forward to once Sioux Falls landed an event like this?

KIRK TRIPLETT: Oh, absolutely. Every time we go somewhere new I like to try and play the first year, for sure. The community can rest assured it's a great tournament, people really enjoyed every aspect of it. The weather kind of busted us in the chops earlier in the week, but yeah, pretty nice by the weekend. I think this event has a real chance for long-term success.
