SCOTT PAREL (-14)



**SCOTT PAREL:** You know, my last 11 holes I don't even -- I kind of blacked out. You know when you have those things. I hit the ball great today. I've been in a good place for the last few weeks and made a few putts on the back nine.

# Q. I mean, we're just watching McCarron get on here in 2 now. How do you think you're sort of -- a little bit tough given the spot, 14 under?

**SCOTT PAREL:** Yeah. I mean, I really needed to make that. I mean, to have a chance, I figure I needed to make that putt. I was looking at the board when I went by and I saw that they were already 14. At least one of them and probably both of them will make birdie on the last hole, so I had to get to 15 to have a chance.

# Q. Just maybe give us a sense of how good your game is feeling right now, I mean, coming off of last week and then coming in here and finishing the way you did today?

**SCOTT PAREL:** Yeah, it's probably felt as good as it ever has. I'm playing very free right now. It seems like every shot I have a plan and I'm executing it. A lot of times there's indecision. Right now I'm not very indecisive about much of anything, so that's very key.

### Q. Good feeling as you finish off and head towards the Charles Schwab Cup?

**SCOTT PAREL:** Yeah, for sure. We got a week off and I need it, but the way I'm playing, I kind of -- I almost wish we would keep playing.

## Q. To come in here and be in the mix today, are you pretty happy with your game today?

**SCOTT PAREL:** Oh, sure, sure. Five shots back when I started, which is how I was last week when I won. But when I saw those guys got out pretty good early, you know, then you just pedal to the metal, make as many birdies as you can and see what happens.

### Q. You had an eagle putt on that?

SCOTT PAREL: Yeah.

### Q. How long was that?

**SCOTT PAREL:** Probably 20 feet or something.
