

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

SCOTT McCARRON (-10)

Q. Ended up with a 63 and a nice finish there.

SCOTT McCARRON: Yeah, yeah. I started off really well, I was like 4 under through the first four holes. Drove one of the par 4s there, three-putted, so it kind of stalled my round a little bit. But I hung in there, I played some really good golf. Got back on the other side and made a couple birdies and made one bogey on the par 3, and then finished really well today, birdied the last three holes to finish it up.

Q. What part of your game felt the best today?

SCOTT McCARRON: Well, I made a lot of putts. I drove the ball well, which you've got to do here. You've got to put the ball in play first and then you've got to make a lot of putts, and today I was able to make a bunch of putts.

Q. What was your thought when you got to the ninth green and saw your lie on the back side?

SCOTT McCARRON: Well, I was surprised. I had 138 from the fairway there and I hit pitching wedge, which I can only hit pitching wedge about 130, and we just got a little gust of wind and flew like 150. I was surprised it flew that far. But I had a decent lie there. It wasn't a difficult chip, but it wasn't one I was really thinking about making. But I hit a beautiful chip there and it just rolled right in, caught the left edge. Great way to finish.

Q. Two strokes off the course record here. How does this compare to how you've been playing for the last couple months?

SCOTT McCARRON: Well, I just won the last tournament, so I've been playing some good golf. I've had a lot of opportunities over the last couple months to win tournaments and my game feels good. Yesterday I played very nicely, I just didn't make any putts, so today I was able to play well and finally the putts started dropping, so it was good.
