Q. How would you compare your sec round to your first?

BARNHARD LANGER: The first day I made some putts, and today I found it difficult to get the ball near the hole. On the outward nine the wind was so strong I never got the ball anywhere near. I always had 50-footers, 80-footers. And hit two beautiful shots on five, a drive and a 9-iron, and the ball wouldn't -- again, I had 100-foot putt, three-putted, which was really a birdie hole today. And that hurt. But I played very solid, no bogeys. Had plenty of opportunities, hit most of the reasons greens in regulation, and toward the end we got a nice break. The last three or four holes the wind kind of dropped and it was a lot easier than it would have been three hours ago.

Q. You mentioned the conditions for the weekend. Supposed to be windy and wet.

BARNHARD LANGER: Any other good news?

Q. No. You would not in Wales last year in these conditions. Does that give you a little more confidence considering what happened last year? BARNHARD LANGER: Well, I've played in all sorts of weather, and most of us have. When you get to our age you're doomed to have some of the worst, and Wales was some of the worst for a period of time. And I hope it's not going to be that bad on the weekend, but we'll deal with it whatever comes our way.
