Today – Scattered showers and a few thunderstorms over northeastern Georgia may hold together to bring a round of rain and embedded storms between 6:30-8:30am. Expect a lull from mid-morning to noon, with just an isolated shower or thunderstorm risk. Thunderstorm chances will increase from 12-6pm, starting earlier at The Cliffs Valley and later at Thornblade Club. There will be a 40% risk for storms at Thornblade and a 50% risk at The Cliffs Valley. The temperature will reach a high in the mid 80s. **Rainfall:** 0.10-0.25" **Sunrise: 6:16am / Sunset: 8:40pm**

Extended forecast – An upper level low across the Lower Mississippi Valley/Western Tennessee Valley will transport tropical moisture into the region Friday through the weekend, bringing likely chances for rain and scattered thunderstorms. Rain will be possible at any time Friday through Sunday, though chances are expected to be highest during the afternoon through early evening each day. Rain will be heavy at times, with total rainfall of 2-4" likely through the weekend. Strong to severe thunderstorms are not expected.
