Today – An area of off and on moderate to heavy showers will lift through the area between 6:30-8:00am. This first round of rain will have low (20%) lightning chances. A larger cluster of heavy rain and embedded thunderstorms currently over central Georgia is expected to impact the area from mid-morning to early afternoon, with the greatest risk from 10am-2pm. Expect a relative lull from 2-4pm before thunderstorms redevelop in the late afternoon and continue into this evening.

Extended forecast – An upper level low across the Tennessee Valley will transport tropical moisture into the region through the weekend, bringing likely chances for rain and scattered thunderstorms. Saturday and Sunday will continue to see periods of moderate to heavy rain and embedded thunderstorms. Rainfall of 2–4" is anticipated this weekend, with locally higher amounts possible. Strong to severe thunderstorms are not expected this weekend, though flash flooding will be a concern.
