Extended forecast – A deep marine layer will keep a threat for fog in the forecast Wednesday through Friday. Areas of fog that develop would likely burn off between 9-10am each morning. High pressure is forecast to suppress the marine layer depth this weekend, likely pushing the potential for fog below the golf course. Breezy west to west-northwesterly winds are forecast to develop each afternoon. Temperatures are forecast to reach highs in the middle to upper 70s Wednesday through Friday before warming into the low 80s this weekend.
