Today – The marine layer has been compressed below the golf course, likely keeping any fog potential below the course this morning. Expect sunny to mostly sunny skies with a high temperature in the upper 70s. Southwesterly winds will turn west-southwesterly and increase in speed this afternoon. The overnight low will be in the mid 50s with fog becoming possible early Thursday as the marine layer depth is forecast to increase. **Sunrise: 6:11am / Sunset: 8:18pm**

Extended forecast – A deep marine layer will keep a threat for fog in the forecast through Friday. Areas of fog that develop would likely burn off between 9-10am each morning. High pressure is forecast to suppress the marine layer depth this weekend, likely pushing the potential for fog below the golf course. Breezy west to west-northwesterly winds are forecast to develop each afternoon. Temperatures are forecast to reach highs in the middle to upper 70s Wednesday through Friday before warming into the low 80s this weekend.
