A weak frontal boundary is expected to be situated over central Illinois Sunday afternoon with the potential for isolated to widely scattered T-storms after 2-3pm. This threat is conditional and will depend on how much clearing can take place. Winds will be out of the west to southwest at 6-14 mph. Temperatures should reach the lower 80s. Rainfall: < 0.25". **Sunrise: 5:30am / Sunset: 8:28pm**
