




Shower and thunderstorm chances will slowly increase this evening and overnight with a 40% risk expected by daybreak Thursday.

Extended forecast – A few showers and thunderstorms will be a possibility throughout the day on Thursday, though the greatest precipitation chances may hold just north of the area. Thursday night and Friday will see thunderstorms become more organized along a weak frontal boundary, with a couple rounds of thunderstorms possible overnight Thursday/early Friday and again Friday afternoon. Showers and thunderstorms are expected to become more numerous on Saturday as an upper level disturbance moves across the area. After some light morning showers, dry conditions return for Sunday afternoon.
