

**Today** – Isolated pop-up showers and thunderstorms are a possibility this morning, with a scattered coverage of showers and thunderstorms expected to materialize this afternoon. A few storms may produce gusty winds, small hail, and brief heavy downpours. Daily rainfall is expected to hold below 0.25". South-southwesterly winds will increase this afternoon, with gusts in the 15-18 mph range.

**Extended forecast** – Thursday night and Friday will see a couple rounds of scattered thunderstorms as a frontal boundary sets up to our northwest. The first round of storms will look to arrive late Thursday night into early Friday morning with additional redevelopment expected for Friday afternoon. Showers and thunderstorms will become numerous for much of Saturday as an upper level disturbance works through the region. Light showers will linger into Sunday morning before dry conditions return for Sunday afternoon.
