Extended Forecast – While a rain shower can't be ruled out on Abaco Thursday/Friday, mainly dry conditions are expected each day. East-southeast flow will develop on Saturday and this should bring a higher threat for showers. In addition winds will increase as the day progresses with gusts of 15-20 mph possible. Shower chances increase even more into Sunday ahead of an approaching cold front. Thunderstorms could also occur late Sunday afternoon into Sunday evening.
