#### ShotLink Keys to Victory for Aaron Wise

Aaron Wise recorded his first career PGA TOUR victory and recorded the 500<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR win by a former Web.com Tour player. Wise earned 500 FedExCup points and moved from 56th to 18th in the standings. Aaron Wise shot rounds of 65 in his first and final rounds of the AT&T Byron Nelson to collect his first PGA TOUR win.

**63%** of Wise's total strokes gained for the week were a result of his performance off the tee and approach the green at Trinity Forest. Wise ranked second in SG: Off-the-Tee & first in SG: Approach-the-Green for the week.

Aaron Wise was the first winner since Dustin Johnson (2017 THE NORTHERN TRUST) to rank either first or second in both SG: Off-the-Tee & SG: Approach-the-Green en route to victory.

### Highest GIR % in a Four Round Stroke Play Event by a Winner PGA TOUR Since 1997

Wise ranked ninth in Driving Distance (all drives) averaging 295.5 yards off the tee and ranked first in Greens in Regulation, hitting his mark 91.67% of the time. Wise had the highest GIR percentage by a winner on TOUR since 1997.

Wise did not miss a Green in Regulation on 13 holes (holes 1, 3-11, 14, 16 & 17<sup>th</sup>) all week.

Since 2007, seven of 12 AT&T Byron Nelson champions have qualified for the TOUR Championship, finishing inside the top 30 in the final FedExCup standings in the same year they won this event.

All 12 winners have qualified for the BMW Championship in the same year (Top 70 in FedExCup).

Defending champion and 2017-18 Rookie of the Year Aaron Wise finished 24<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings.

Jason Day (2010) finished eighth in the final FedExCup standings, marking the best FedExCup finish by a winner at the AT&T Byron Nelson in the FedExCup era.

Last season, the field found the fairway off the tee 79.50% of the time at Trinity Forest GC, marking the easiest fairways to hit on the PGA TOUR.

Last season, the greens at Trinity Forest GC, played as the 2<sup>nd</sup> easiest to hit in regulation on TOUR (76.82%). Trinity Forest GC had the second-highest Going for the Green Percentage of any course, with the field going for the green 80.98% of the time and was a combined 851-under par when going for the green.

#### **Jordan Spieth**

2015 FedExCup champion Jordan Spieth is set to make his ninth start at the AT&T Byron Nelson. Spieth currently ranks 153<sup>rd</sup> in the FedExCup standings.

In his career Jordan Spieth has finished inside the top 10 in 35.19% of his starts on the PGA TOUR (57 of 162). However, the AT&T Byron Nelson is one of three TOUR events where Spieth has made multiple starts without recoding a top-10 finish (WGC-Mexico Championship & Farmers Insurance Open).

Since 2010, Jordan Spieth has the third-most rounds under par in Texas (64), third-best score to par in Texas (128) and t-2<sup>nd</sup> most rounds in the 60s in Texas (52). Spieth averages 4.33 birdies or better per round in stroke-play events in Texas, marking the third best average of players with 25 or more rounds.

#### Hideki Matsuyama

Hideki Matsuyama is set to make his second start at the AT&T Byron Nelson (T16, 2018). Matsuyama currently ranks 43<sup>rd</sup> in the FedExCup standings on the strength of three top 10s and seven top-25 finishes. Since the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season, Hideki Matsuyama has ranked inside the top 30 of the FedExCup in 155 weeks, second-most of any player in this timeframe.

Last season, Hideki Matsuyama ranked 5<sup>th</sup> in SG: Putting, outperforming the field at Trinity Forest GC by +1.464 strokes per round on the greens, marking his second-best SG: Putting performance in an event on the PGA TOUR (4 measured rds).

At the 2018 AT&T Byron Nelson, Hideki Matsuyama made 21.74% (5 of 23) of putts from outside 25 feet, 17% more than the field average (4.72%). Matsuyama's five total putts made from over 25 feet at this tournament last season is his most putts made from this range in an event on TOUR.

#### **Henrik Stenson**

2013 FedExCup champion Henrik Stenson is set to make his tournament debut at the AT&T Byron Nelson. Stenson currently ranks 117<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings with four top-25 finishes. Stenson was one of four players at the Wells Fargo Championship that played their way into the top 125 of the FedExCup standings who started the week outside the number to qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs.

#### **Patrick Reed**

Patrick Reed is set to make his fourth start at the AT&T Byron Nelson and 14<sup>th</sup> start this season. Reed ranks 62<sup>nd</sup> in the FedExCup on the strength of seven top-25 finishes and is seeking to qualify for the TOUR Championship for the sixth consecutive season.

#### **Charles Howell III**

Charles Howell III is set to make his 15<sup>th</sup> start at the AT&T Byron Nelson with three top-10 finishes in his last four starts at this event.
