Things to Know

- Kevin Na wins his third TOUR victory in his 392nd career start
- Na is the only player in the history of this event to record three career rounds of 62 or better
- Na’s victory marks 23rd TOUR title by a Korean-born player
- Tony Finau records his fifth runner-up finish since the start of the 2017-18 season, the most of any player within that span
- After making 434’4” of putts the first three days, Jordan Spieth (T8) makes 46’ of putts in the final round
- Colonial Country Club member Ryan Palmer finishes T6 for his fourth top-10 at Charles Schwab Challenge

Best 2018-19 results: Won/Charles Schwab Challenge, T5/World Golf Championships-Dell Technologies Match Play

- Notches third TOUR victory in his 392nd start at the age of 35 years, 8 months, 11 days
- Moves from No. 98 to No. 27 in the FedExCup standings
- Has finished inside the top 100 in the FedExCup standings every year except for 2013, where he played only eight events due to a back injury
- One of 14 players to qualify for the TOUR Championship in six or more seasons since 2009
- Wins for the second time in his sixth attempt with the 54-hole lead/co-lead (2011 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open, 2019 Charles Schwab Challenge)
- Is the only player in the history of this event to record three career rounds of 62 or better

- Marks 23rd TOUR victory by a Korean-born player: K.J. Choi (8), Kevin Na (3), Y.E. Yang (2), Sangmoon Bae (2), James Hahn (2), Si Woo Kim (2), Seung-Yul Noh (1), Danny Lee (1), Michael Kim (1), Sung Kang (1)
- Justin Rose (2018) and Na (2019) are the first players born outside the United States to win back-to-back at the Charles Schwab Challenge since Sergio Garcia (2001) and Nick Price (2002)
- Na's margin of victory in his three TOUR wins: 4/2019 Charles Schwab Challenge, 5/2018 A Military Tribute at the Greenbrier, 2/2011 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open
- Cumulative Stats: 34/56 fairways hit, 56/72 greens in regulation, 114 putts, Strokes Gained: Approach The Green/1st (8.296), Strokes Gained: Putting/2nd (7.033)

Jordan Spieth (T8/-5)

- After starting the final round two shots back, carded final-round 2-over 72 to finish T8
- Made 46' of putts in the final round, while making over 125 feet of putts in each of his first three rounds
- Made a total of 480' 4" of putts at the 2019 Charles Schwab Challenge, the most he's ever made in a TOUR event
- Most feet of made putts by Spieth in a four-round event:
 - 480' 4" – 2019 Charles Schwab Challenge/T8
 - 432' 5" – 2015 TOUR Championship/Won
 - 431' 6" – 2016 Charles Schwab Challenge/Won
 - 410' 10" – 2015 Valero Texas Open/2nd
- Made three putts outside of 40 feet for the first time in a TOUR event
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (7.473) through 72 holes
- Other than a T32 in 2018, has finished no worse than T14 in seven trips around Colonial Country Club (T7/2013, T14/2014, T2/2015, 1/2016, T2/2017, T32/2018, T8/2019)

Additional Player Notes

- Tony Finau birdied his 72nd hole to finish solo second, recording his fifth runner-up finish since the start of the 2017-18 season (most of any player on TOUR)
- Andrew Putnam (T3) earned his third top-10 finish of the season (T4/WGC-HSBC Champions, 2nd/2019 Sony Open in Hawaii) and his best result at the Charles Schwab Challenge in two trips around Colonial Country Club
- 35 days following his maiden victory at the 2019 RBC Heritage, C.T. Pan finished T3 for his best finish at the Charles Schwab Challenge in three starts; was seeking to become the winningest golfer from Chinese Taipei with the victory
- Ryan Palmer (T6), who plays out of Colonial Country Club, finished inside the top 15 for the fifth time in his last eight starts at the Charles Schwab Challenge (T6/2019, MC/2018, T70/2017, T3/2016, MC/2015, T5/2014, T14/2013, T5/2012)
- Reigning FedExCup champion Justin Rose finished T58 in his bid to join Ben Hogan as the only back-to-back winners of the Charles Schwab Challenge
