

## 2019 Farmers Insurance Open Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



### ShotLink Keys to Victory for Jason Day

Jason Day made birdie on the sixth playoff hole (18<sup>th</sup> hole) to defeat Alex Noren for his 11<sup>th</sup> career PGA TOUR victory in his 214<sup>th</sup> career start on TOUR. Day moved from 76<sup>th</sup> to ninth in the FedExCup standings with his win at the 2018 Farmers Insurance Open. The six-hole playoff between Jason Day and Alex Noren (Ryan Palmer-eliminated 1<sup>st</sup> hole) marked the fifth PGA TOUR event to go to extra holes and the 20<sup>th</sup> playoff hole played last season.

56.7% of Day's total strokes gained for three rounds on Torrey Pines GC (South) were a result of his off the tee performance.

**76<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup>:** Jason Day entered the 2018 Farmers Insurance Open 76<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings and moved to ninth in the FedExCup with his win, marking the first time Day has ranked inside the top-10 of the standings since the 2016 TOUR Championship (6<sup>th</sup>).

Last season, Jason Day played the 18<sup>th</sup> hole at Torrey Pines South in one-under par in three rounds of regulation (rd 1,3 & 4) compared to four-under par in four attempts in the six-hole playoff.

**95' 10":** Day made 95' 10" of putts in the final round, marking the fourth winner of the Farmers Insurance Open to make over 90 feet of putts in the final round en route to victory since 2013.

Jason Day had two different results on the greens at Torrey Pines (South) in his first two rounds (rd 1 & 3) compared to the final round. Day outperformed the field by +2.69 strokes in SG: Putting in the final round compared to losing -0.61 strokes in rounds one and three.

This season, there are eight players who rank inside the top 30 of the FedExCup entering the 2019 Farmers Insurance Open that ranked inside the top 30 entering this event in 2018.

In the FedExCup era, 10 of the 12 Farmers Insurance Open champions have qualified for the TOUR Championship in the same year after winning at Torrey Pines GC. The last four consecutive Farmers Insurance Open champions have finished inside the top 30 of the final FedExCup standings. Tiger Woods (2007) and Brandt Snedeker (2012) are the only two players to win the Farmers Insurance Open and the FedExCup in the same season. The Farmers Insurance Open is one of four regular season events where the winners have won the FedExCup title in the same season multiple times.

#### Tiger Woods

Two-time (2007 & 2009) FedExCup Champion, Tiger Woods has ranked in the number one spot of the FedExCup standings for a total of 85 weeks in his career. His 85 weeks in the number one position is 37 more weeks than any other player on TOUR. Woods is making his first start since winning the 2018 TOUR Championship and is seeking to win in back-to-back starts for the 26<sup>th</sup> time of his PGA TOUR career.

Tiger Woods holds eight wins at three separate courses on TOUR, including Torrey Pines. Tiger's first win at Torrey Pines on the PGA TOUR came in 1999 and his last came at the 2008 U.S. Open where he defeated Rocco Mediate in a playoff. Tiger's first PGA TOUR victory at the Farmers Insurance Open came in dramatic fashion making eagle on the 72<sup>nd</sup> hole to win the tournament.

Only two players have won a single event eight times on the PGA TOUR, Sam Snead and Tiger Woods. Tiger has accomplished this feat at two events (WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational and Arnold Palmer Invitational) and Snead accomplished this feat at the Wyndham Championship.

43 of Tiger's 80 PGA TOUR victories have come in three states: Florida, California and Ohio. Since 1997, Tiger has won 14 times in the state of California, three more victories than Phil Mickelson (11).

**Performance in next official start after winning TOUR Championship:** Tiger Woods won in each of his starts following winning the TOUR Championship. Woods won the 1999 TOUR Championship and followed by the 1999 WGC-Mexico Championship (held at Valderrama GC). Following the 2007 TOUR Championship victory, Tiger Woods won 2008 Farmers Insurance Open by eight strokes. In both his starts following his first two TOUR Championship victories Tiger Woods had a scoring average of 68.38, played all eight rounds at par or better. Tiger averaged 5.25 birdies or better per round in both these starts (1999 WGC-Mexico and 2008 Farmers Insurance Open).

**166-Under Par:** Since 1998, Tiger Woods is a combined 166-under par at the Farmers Insurance Open, **67-strokes** better than Phil Mickelson (-99). In 17 previous starts at this event, Woods has seven wins, 12 top 10s and 13 top-25 finishes.

Since 2008, Tiger Woods has struggled on the first hole at Torrey Pines GC (South). In his last 19 rounds played, he has made a combined four double bogeys (three at 2008 U.S. Open) and has played the hole at an average of 4.38 strokes. In his previous 29 rounds, he was a combined six-under par, recording zero double bogeys and playing the hole at an average of 3.79.
