Things to Know

- 2017 Farmers Insurance Open winner Rahm matched his career low in 202 rounds on PGA TOUR
- Eleven of the 14 players to shoot 66 or better played the North Course
- For third consecutive year, Rose opens with sub-70 score after posting just one first-round sub-70 in his first seven appearances
- Sponsor exemption Ghim recorded 63 in his 10th PGA TOUR start
- Pan records 10 birdies in a round for the first time in his PGA TOUR career
- Spieth posted a 65 in his first start at Torrey Pines since 2015
- Brandon Hagy, Chris Stroud and Charles Howell III post low round on the South Course (66)

First-Round Lead Notes

- 61 Lowest R1 score (Brandt Snedeker/NC/2007)
- 63 Low start by a winner (George Burns/1987)
- 32 Years since George Burns (1987) was last first-round leader/co-leader to go on to win the Farmers Insurance Open
- 3 First-round leaders/co-leaders to win on TOUR in 2018-19 (most recent: Charles Howell III/The RSM Classic)
- 8 Consecutive winners to play South Course in first round (Ben Crane/2010 was last player to start on North Course and win)
- Last five winners have shot 72 or higher in first round (Tiger Woods/2013/68 is last player to start with sub-70 and win: Jason Day/2018/73, Jon Rahm/2017/72, Brandt Snedeker/2016/73, Jason Day/2015/73, Scott Stallings/2014/72)

Age: 24 (November 10, 1994)

Entering the week

- 2 Starts at Farmers Insurance Open
- 1 Wins at Farmers Insurance Open (2017)
- 58 PGA TOUR starts
- 2 PGA TOUR wins
- 3 Starts in 2018-19
- 2 Top-10s in 2018-19 (T8/Sentry Tournament of Champions, 6th/Desert Classic)
 - Opened with 7-under 29 on back nine of North Course, posting two eagles (Nos. 10 and 17), before closing with four birdies in last five holes for 10-under 62, matching career low on TOUR (R1/2018 Desert Classic)

- Only Brandt Snedeker (27/back nine/NC/2007), Jeff Julian (28/back nine/NC/1996) and Nick Watney (28/back nine/SC/2011) have posted lower nine-hole scores at the Farmers Insurance Open
- Hit 7/14 fairways, 15/18 greens and needed 26 putts
- Won his first career PGA TOUR title at the 2017 Farmers Insurance Open. Posted T29 while defending in 2018
- In November, won the Hero World Challenge for his sixth worldwide victory
- Posted 2-and-1 win over Tiger Woods in Singles at 2018 Ryder Cup in France

Justin Rose - NC (T2/-9)

- World No. 1 opened with an eagle at No. 10 and notched seven birdies for bogey-free 9-under 63, his lowest score in 33 rounds at Torrey Pines (including 2008 U.S. Open)
- Marked third consecutive year he's opened Farmers Insurance Open with a sub-70 round (65/2017, 69/2018, 63/2019) after posting one (68/2007) in his first seven starts
- Owns top-10s in his last two starts at the Farmers Insurance Open (T8/2018, T4/2017)
- Making his 10th career start in the Farmers Insurance Open
- Finished T34 at last week's Desert Classic, his second start of the season following a third-place showing in the World Golf Championships-HSBC Champions
- Won the 2017-18 FedExCup by a margin of 41 points over Tiger Woods

Doug Ghim - NC (T2/-9)

- After a bogey at No. 3 to sit 1-over, posted nine birdies, all in an 11-hole stretch (Nos. 4-14), before an additional bogey at No. 16 and an eagle at No. 17 for 9-under 63 in his tournament debut
- 63 marks lowest round on TOUR (24 rounds): previous-low was 64/R2/2018 Wyndham Classic
- Playing on a sponsor exemption, makes his third PGA TOUR start of the season after two starts in the fall (71st/Sanderson Farms Championship, MC/Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- Last week, he finished T45 in his first start on the Web.com Tour at The Bahamas Great Exuma Classic
- Former University of Texas golfer finished runner-up in the 2017 U.S. Amateur to Doc Redman at the 37th hole
- Made his first cut as a professional at the 2018 Quicken Loans National (T71)
- Posted T20 at the 2018 Wyndham Championship with four rounds in the 60s for his best TOUR result to date

C.T Pan - NC (4th/-8)

- Recorded 10 birdies and two bogeys en route to 8-under 64
- Ten birdies in a round is most in his career (223 rounds: previous best was eight in R1 of 2018 CIMB Classic)
- Finished T2 in his first Farmers Insurance Open appearance during his rookie season in 2017 with 70-69-69-70 and T35 last year with 70-70-68-79
- With two career runner-up finishes (T2/2017 Farmers Insurance Open, T2/2018 Wyndham Championship), seeks first PGA TOUR win in his 71st career start
- Recorded three top-25s in six starts this season with T16 at Mayakoba Golf Classic his best result

Jordan Spieth - NC (5th/-7)

- Opening-round 65 marks lowest round on TOUR since 64 in R3 of 2018 THE NORTHERN TRUST (4 months, 30 days ago)
- Playing the Farmers Insurance Open for the first time since 2015; Only made cut in three previous starts was a T19 in 2014
- Made his professional debut on TOUR at the 2013 Farmers Insurance Open
- Has missed cuts in his last two starts on TOUR: 2019 Sony Open in Hawaii, 2018 Mayakoba Golf Classic

Charles Howell III - SC (T6/-6)

- Joins Brandon Hagy and Chris Stroud as low score for R1 on the South Course (also only bogey-free round on South Course)
- Hit 17 greens in regulation, only player to do so on South Course in R1
- Making 17th consecutive appearance at Farmers Insurance Open where he owns eight top-10s, including three runner-up results (T2/2017, 2nd/2007, T2/2005)
- Never missed a cut in 17 starts at this event
- Recorded third career PGA TOUR win with victory at The RSM Classic this season. Also posted top-10s at CIMB Classic (T5) and Sony Open in Hawaii (T8)

Bud Cauley - NC (T6/-6)

- Making sixth appearance at Farmers Insurance Open with T13 in his tournament debut (2102) his best result
- Never posted an over-par score in the opening round at this event
- T10 at Shriners Hospitals for Children Open is lone top-10 result in five starts this season (MC at last week's Desert Classic)

- T10 in Vegas was first top-10 finish since car accident in June 2018 left him hospitalized with multiple injuries
- Won 2014 Hotel Fitness Championship on Web.com Tour but seeks first PGA TOUR win in his 145th career start on TOUR
- Owns three 3rd-place finishes on TOUR most recent, T3 at 2017 Desert Classic

Tiger Woods - SC (T53/-2)

- Making first start of the 2018-19 PGA TOUR Season and first since winning the 2018 TOUR Championship, his 80th career PGA TOUR title, mixed five birdies, including one at the final hole, and three bogeys for 2-under 70
- 70 marks his first sub-par opening-round at Farmers Insurance Open since 68 in 2013, his most recent win of eight at Torrey Pines
- Hit 7/14 fairways, 12/18 greens and needed 28 putts. Proximity to the hole on approach shots was 32'11" (ranked T25)

Additional Player Notes

- Defending champion **Jason Day** sits T15 after a first-round 67 at the North Course. Marks first time he's broken par in the opening-round of this event since 2014 (66)
- Rory McIlroy's 1-under 71 at the South Course leaves him T74 in his first appearance at the Farmers Insurance Open
- Braden Thornberry (T74) posted a 1-under 71 on the South Course in his professional debut on the PGA TOUR
- Farmers Insurance ambassador **Rickie Fowler** (T118) failed to break par in the opening round for the fourth consecutive time, finishing bogey-bogey for 1-over 73 at the South Course. Fowler missed the cut each of the last three years
- Jon Rahm and Richy Werenski were the only players to record two eagles in the opening round (last player to record two eagles in a round Adam Long (R3/La Quinta), winner of last week's Desert Classic
- Peter Malnati withdrew before the start of round one with a back injury and was replaced by Brady Schnell (T133/74/NC)
