Things to Know

- Justin Rose ties 36-hole record at Farmers Insurance Open with a 15-under 129 and leads by three
- Tiger Woods posted his second straight 70 and sits 11 shots off the lead
- San Diego native and FedExCup leader Xander Schauffele makes the cut for the first time in four starts at Torrey Pines
- In his tournament debut, Rory McIlroy posted a 7-under 65, the best round of the day on the North Course
- Justin Rose and Hideki Matsuyama recorded the best second-round score on the South Course, 6-under 66
- The last eight winners of the Farmers Insurance Open started the week on the South Course. Ben Crane (2010) was the last champion to start play on the North Course.

Justin Rose

- World No. 1 opened with rounds of 63-66 to tie the 36-hole tournament record (129) held by Lennie Clements/1996 (finished T3) and Tom Lehman/2005 (finished T2)
- Marks Rose's 15th second-round lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR, and first since the 2018 TOUR Championship; He went on to win four of 14 previous 36-hole lead/co-leads, most recently at the 2018 Charles Schwab Challenge
- Marks second, second-round lead held at Farmers Insurance Open (2017/T4)
- Missed only two greens in each of his first two rounds (32/36)
- Making his 10th career start at the Farmers Insurance Open
- Finished in the top-10 the last two years (2018/T8 and 2017/T4)
- Is in search of his 10th career PGA TOUR victory; Won twice in 2017-18, his second season with multiple wins (2010)
- In two previous starts on TOUR this season, Rose finished third (WGC-HSBC Champions) and T34 (Desert Classic)

Hideki Matsuyama

- Marks his best 36 holes in six starts at the Farmers Insurance Open
- Finished T12 at the 2018 Farmers Insurance Open, his best showing
- Is in search of first TOUR win since the 2017 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational

Jon Rahm

- A day after his 10-under 62 on the North Course, recorded an even-par 72 on the South Course
- En route to his 2017 victory at the Farmers Insurance Open, was five shots off Justin Rose's lead

Rory McIlroy

- Sits seven shots of the lead in his first start at the Farmers Insurance Open
- One-putted for eagle on his first hole of the day (No. 10/NC) and holed-out for eagle on the 16th, marking the fourth round on TOUR he recorded multiple eagles
- Finished T4 in his most recent TOUR start, his tournament debut at the Sentry Tournament of Champions

Xander Schauffele

- Followed a 3-under 69 (SC) with a 2-under 70 to play his first weekend at Torrey Pines in four starts
- Was a perfect 5-for-5 in Scrambling in the second round
- Sits T37, 10 back as he searches for his third consecutive win in as many starts on TOUR

Additional Player Notes

- A year after he was eliminated on the first hole of the Jason Day-Alex Noren playoff, **Ryan Palmer** is T3, five shots off pace
- In his 10th career start at Torrey Pines, **Rickie Fowler** (T37) fired seven birdies against one bogey on the North Course for a 6-under 66 and will play the weekend for the first time since 2015
- Defending champion **Jason Day** sits T30 after posting a 1-under 71 on the South Course
- After an opening 7-under 65 on the North Course, **Jordan Spieth** (T18) posted an even-par 72 on the South Course
- A week after his maiden PGA TOUR win at the Desert Classic, PGA TOUR rookie **Adam Long** missed the cut
- In his professional debut, **Braden Thornberry** posted a second-round 5-under 67 on the North Course and is T30.
