Chez Reavie

Chez Reavie earned his second PGA TOUR victory in his 278th start on TOUR last week at the Travelers Championship. Reavie moved from 35th to 12th in the FedExCup standings and from 22nd to 13th in the U.S. Presidents Cup standings. Recording his second win 3,983 days since his first PGA TOUR win at the 2008 RBC Canadian Open, marking the 11th longest span between a player first and second win on TOUR since 1900.
