ShotLink Keys to Victory for Ryan Armour

Ryan Armour earned 300 points moving to the ninth position in the FedExCup standings with his first career victory on the PGA TOUR at the 2017 Sanderson Farms Championship.

84.3% of Ryan's total strokes gained for the week were a result of both his approach the green and putting performances at the CC of Jackson.

Ryan Armour became the 28th winner (since 2004) to rank inside the top-three in SG: Approach-the-Green & Putting en route to victory.

Armour's performance on the back 9 was phenomenal making 273' 10" in total putts and outperformed the field by +7.05 in SG: Putting. Armour's 441' 3" total feet of putts made was the 12th most by a winner in the ShotLink era.

264 Yards from the Tee: Ryan Armour ranked 74th (out of 75 players) for driving distance (all drives) en route to his victory at the Sanderson Farms Championship. His 264.0 average drive from the tee is the shortest ever recorded by a winner at the Sanderson Farms Championship since 2003. Ryan Armour chose to lay-up on 17 of 20 (85%) going for it holes at CC of Jackson, marking the 3rd highest lay-up percentage among winners on TOUR since 2003.

2013-14 Wrap-Around: 186 players earned FedExCup points before the start of the new calendar year in the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season. Of those 186 players, 115 made the 2014 FedExCup Playoffs, 92 made it to the Dell Technologies Championship, 63 made it to the BMW Championship and 26 made it to the TOUR Championship.

2014-15 Wrap-Around: 206 players earned FedExCup points before the start of the new calendar year in the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season. Of those 206 players, 118 made the 2015 FedExCup Playoffs, 94 made it to the Dell Technologies Championship, 64 made it to the BMW Championship and 25 made it to the TOUR Championship.

2015-16 Wrap-Around: 209 players earned FedExCup points before the start of the new calendar year in the 2015-16 PGA TOUR season. Of those 209 players, 116 made the 2016 FedExCup Playoffs, 92 made it to the Dell Technologies Championship, 65 made it to the BMW Championship and 27 made it to the TOUR Championship.

2016-17 Wrap-Around: 213 players earned FedExCup points before the start of the new calendar year in the 2016-17 PGA TOUR season. Of those 213 players, 117 made the 2017 FedExCup Playoffs, 93 made it to the Dell Technologies Championship, 63 made it to the BMW Championship and 24 made it to the TOUR Championship.

2017-18 Wrap-Around: 206 players earned FedExCup points before the start of the new calendar year in the 2017-18 PGA TOUR season. Of those 206 players, 115 (55.8%) made the 2018 FedExCup Playoffs, 92 (44.7%) made it to the Dell Technologies Championship, 64 (31.1%) made it to the BMW Championship and 27 (13.1%) made it to the TOUR Championship.

From the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season to the 2016-17 season, the average total FEC points earned during the season opening events was 20,555. +0.348: Last season, the 16th hole at CC of Jackson played as the seventh toughest hole on the PGA TOUR (non-majors). The par-4 16th hole played to a scoring average of +0.348-over par and the field combined for 25 total birdies and 28 double bogeys or worse at the 2017 Sanderson Farms Championship.

Ryan Armour

Defending Sanderson Farms champion Ryan Armour is set to make his sixth start at this event. Armour became the fourth consecutive player to capture their first PGA TOUR victory at the Sanderson Farms Championship. Since the start of the ShotLink era (2003), the longest streak of First-Time winners at an event is six (Shriners Hospitals) and six total events have been won by four or more first-time winners in this timeframe. The Sanderson Farms Championship and The RSM Classic have the longest current streak with four.

2016 Sanderson Farms champion Cody Gribble is set to make his third start at this event and 61st of his PGA TOUR career.

Since 2014, Cody Gribble has the lowest stroke average of any player at the Country Club of Jackson (68.67). Four of Gribble's six rounds played at this course have been in the 60s.

En route to victory in 2016, Cody Gribble outperformed the field by +2.200 strokes per round on the greens, marking his career-best SG: Putting performance on TOUR. The last four consecutive winners at this event have ranked inside the top 10 in SG: Putting.

Putting 4-8 Feet: Cody was a perfect 9 of 9 from 4-8 feet for the week marking the 17th winner since 2003 to go perfect from this distance. The last player to accomplish this feat was Brian Stuard at the 2016 Zurich Classic of New Orleans where he went 7 of 7 (3 round event).

Wesley Bryan

Wesley Bryan is set to make his tournament debut at the Sanderson Farms Championship. Last season, Bryan spent 13 total weeks ranked inside the top 125 and two weeks ranked inside the top 70 with highest rank in the FedExCup standings was 64th (week #3) before finishing the season 163rd in the final standings. In the 2016-17 PGA TOUR season, Bryan spent 22 more weeks inside the top 125, 29 more weeks ranked inside the top 70 and finished 41st in the final season standings.

Jonas Blixt is making his second start of the 2018-19 PGA TOUR season and coming off the first year to not qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs. Jonas Blixt has played his last eight rounds on the PGA TOUR par or better with a 69.0 stroke average in this stretch. Blixt has outperformed the field by +0.574 strokes in SG: Putting in his last eight rounds.

At the 2018 Safeway Open, Blixt outperformed the field by +1.011 strokes per round in SG: Putting, marking the 22nd PGA TOUR event of his career gaining over a stroke on the greens (4 measured round events). Blixt finishes inside the top-35 in 68% of his starts when gaining over a stroke per round in this category.
