

## 2019 Sentry Tournament of Champions Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



### ShotLink Keys to Victory for Dustin Johnson

In his 223<sup>rd</sup> career PGA TOUR start, Dustin Johnson captured his 17<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR win. Johnson moved from 25<sup>th</sup> to second in the FedExCup standings with his win at the 2018 Sentry Tournament of Champions. Johnson has now won at least one PGA TOUR event in 11 consecutive seasons, marking the longest active streak and the fourth best all-time streak on TOUR.

**82.8% (+3.497)** of Dustin's total strokes gained for the week were a result of his tee to green performance at the Plantation course at Kapalua.

Dustin Johnson would go onto win two more times in the 2017-18 to bring his career win total to 19 victories (FedEx St. Jude Classic & RBC Canadian Open). Since 2008, Dustin Johnson has won 19 times on the PGA TOUR, tied with Tiger Woods for the most wins by any player in this span.

On 22 of the 44 (50.0%) par 4s played, Dustin Johnson left himself less than 100 yards to the hole for his second shot. For the week, Johnson averaged 92 yards to the hole on second shots into par 4s, 24 yards closer than the field (116 yards).

## FedExCup Notes

Since the start of the FedExCup era (2007), 11 of the 12 past winners of the Sentry Tournament of Champions have qualified for the TOUR Championship. Over the last 12 seasons, the Sentry Tournament of Champions is one of six regular season events that have 11 past winners qualify for the TOUR Championship in the season winning the tournament.


