ShotLink Keys to Victory for Patrick Cantlay

Patrick Cantlay earned 500 points and moved to the third position in the FedExCup standings with his first career victory on the PGA TOUR at the 2017 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. Cantlay recorded his fifth top-15 finish in his last six starts with his win at this event last season.

For the week, Cantlay ranked T8 in Driving Distance - All Drives (305.6 yards) and T5 in Driving Accuracy, hitting 64.29% (36 of 56) fairways en route to victory at the 2017 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open.

From inside 100 yards, TPC Summerlin had the second longest Proximity to the Hole average when in the rough and third longest average on approaches from this distance when in the fairway.

Webb Simpson

Webb Simpson (2013 Shriners Hospitals champion) is set to make his eighth start at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. The 2018 PLAYERS champion finished 11th in the final 2017-18 FedExCup standings on the strength of one win (THE PLAYERS), nine top 10s and 16 top-25 finishes. Since 2011, Webb Simpson is one of seven players to qualify for the TOUR Championship in six or more seasons.

Rickie Fowler

2015 PLAYERS champion Rickie Fowler is set to make his fourth start at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. Since 2009, Rickie Fowler has the lowest scoring average of any player at this course with a minimum of 12 rounds played (67.75). In this span, Fowler averages 4.75 birdies per round and 11 of his 12 rounds played at TPC Summerlin have been under par.

Tony Finau is set to make his fifth start at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. Finau is coming off a second-place finish after losing in a playoff to Xander Schauffele at last week's 2018 WGC-HSBC Champions. The last player to lose in a playoff one week, then won a tournament the next was Jordan Spieth in 2015 (Houston Open/Lost, Masters/Won).

Tony Finau enters this week seventh in the FedExCup standings and has spent 65 total weeks inside the top 30 of the FedExCup standings since the start of the 2016-17 season. Ryan Moore

Ryan Moore (2012 champion) is set to make his 13th start at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. Since 2012, Moore is a combined 55-under par, tied with Webb Simpson for the second-best score to par of any player at TPC Summerlin in this span. In this timeframe, Moore has record 15 rounds in the 60s at this course, tied for the most sub-70 rounds of any player.

Jordan Spieth

Jordan Spieth is making his first appearance at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. Spieth is coming off his lowest finish in the FedExCup standings in his career. Spieth failed to make the TOUR Championship for the first time in his career finishing 31st in the final FedExCup standings.

The 2015 FedExCup champion has qualified for the TOUR Championship in five of his six seasons on TOUR. Spieth is one of only eight players who have qualified for the TOUR Championship in five of the last six PGA TOUR seasons.

Jordan Spieth has finished inside of the top two in six (17%) of his 35 events that he played for the first time on TOUR. Spieth's lone win came at the 2017 Travelers Championship, winning in his first start at that event.

Cameron Champ

Cameron Champ won in his ninth start on the PGA TOUR becoming the fifth straight first-time winner of the Sanderson Farms Championship. Champ earned 300 FedExCup points to move into the sixth position in the FedExCup standings.

Cameron Champ ranked second in both Strokes Gained: Off-the-Tee & Putting for the week, becoming the 22nd winner on TOUR (since 2004 where ShotLink lasers were used) to rank inside the top two in both categories en route to victory.

Cameron Champ led the field in Driving Distance (All-Drives) averaging 308 yards off the tee. Champ hit eight drives 340 yards or longer becoming the 42nd winner on TOUR to hit eight or more drives 340 yards or longer in an event in the ShotLink era (Since 2003). His eight drives 340 yards or longer were three more than Tom Lovelady who had the second most with five.

Champ missed only eight putts from 15 feet and in going 66 of 74 (89%) for the week. For the week, Champ averaged nearly 30 yards closer to the hole after his tee shots.

Patrick Cantlay

Defending Shriners Hospitals for Children Open champion Patrick Cantlay is set to make his 67th career start on TOUR. Cantlay finished a career best 20th in the FedExCup standings last season. Patrick Cantlay has spent 44 of his last 50 weeks on TOUR inside the top-30 of the FedExCup standings (88%).

2017 Shriners Hospitals win: Cantlay's performance on the back 9 was phenomenal playing the back 9 in 8-under par, hit 23 of 28 fairways and outperformed the field by +3.70 in SG: Off-the-Tee.
