- Made nine birdies en route to an opening 63 and one-stroke lead
- Marks the first time he has led after any round on the PGA TOUR
- Recorded a front-nine 30 (his second nine), tying his career-best (R3/2018 Wells Fargo Championship)
- Played the par-4s in 6-under and an average of 3.45, a career-best
- Making tournament debut

Seth Reeves (2nd/-7)

- Making third career PGA TOUR start
- Made seven birdies and no bogeys en route to opening 64
- Finished T7 at the Sanderson Farms Championship a week ago
- Finished 24th on 2018 Web.com Tour priority list
- Recorded three individual wins and 10 top-10s in 39 career events at Georgia Tech

Bryson DeChambeau (T5/-5)

- Matched career-best first-round score with an opening 66
- Round included five birdies and no bogeys
- Finished T7 at the 2017 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open; first start at the event came in 2016 (T36)
- Won three times in the 2017-18 season, including twice in the FedExCup Playoffs (THE NORTHERN TRUST, Dell Technologies Championship)

Jordan Spieth (T5/-5)

- Opened with a 66 in tournament and season debuts
- Ranks 3rd in the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (2.912); ranked 136th in that category on TOUR in 2017-18 (-0.088)
- Missed the TOUR Championship for the first time in his career in 2017-18 after a career-low five top-10s
- In search of first victory since 2017 The Open Championship

Miscellaneous Notes

- After playing his first seven holes in 1-over, Harold Varner III (T3) birdied seven of his final 11 holes to get to 6-under
- **Robert Streb** (T3) made five birdies and an eagle en route to the opening 65; eagle came at the par-4 15th, holing approach shot from 58 yards, while lone bogey came at par-3 17th
- Rickie Fowler (T20) made multiple eagles (Nos. 13, 16) in one round for the first time in his PGA TOUR career (747th round)
- Chris Stroud (T32) aced the par-3 14th with an 8-iron from 162 yards; second hole-in-one in TOUR career (2013 THE PLAYERS)
