Things to Know

- Peter Uihlein holds the solo lead for the second consecutive round
- Uihlein’s 36-hole score of 129 is a career-low
- After losing the 2017 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open in a playoff, Whee Kim is tied for second
- Jordan Spieth has a lower 36-hole score than he recorded in any event during the 2017-18 season
- Cameron Champ recorded his first career birdie streak of five holes or more
- Davis Love III made his 566th cut on the PGA TOUR and 21st at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open

- 6 Second-round leaders/co-leaders to win the event since it became a 72-hole tournament in 2004 (Most recent: Rod Pampling/2016)

- After playing the front nine in even-par, made five birdies on the back to shoot a 5-under 66

- Has led after each of the first two rounds; entered the week having never led after any round
- 36-hole score of 129 is career-low (previous: 132/2013 Puerto Rico Open; finished T6)
- Making tournament debut
- Advanced to the FedExCup Playoffs in 2017-18 (rookie season), finishing 64th in the final standings
- Won the 2010 U.S. Amateur at Chambers Bay and has wins on the Web.com Tour (2017 Nationwide Children's Hospital Championship) and European Tour (2013 Madeira Islands Open)

Robert Streb (T2/-11)

- Made five birdies and no bogeys for a 5-under 66
- 36-hole score of 131 ties career-low (2016 PGA Championship; finished T7)
- One top-10 in three previous starts at the event (T10/2014)
- Has a win and three runner-up finishes in 164 prior PGA TOUR starts (win: 2014 The RSM Classic)

Whee Kim (T2/-11)

- Lost the 2017 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open in a playoff to Patrick Cantlay
- The last player to lose a playoff and win the same event the following season was Ryuji Imada at the 2008 AT&T Classic (lost to Zach Johnson in a playoff in 2007)
- Best result in three starts in the 2018-19 season came at the Safeway Open (T33)

Bryson DeChambeau (T4/-10)

- Closed with a back-nine 31 to get to 10-under for the tournament
- Has played the back nine in 9-under (bogey-free) and the front in 1-under for the week
- Looking for third victory in last five starts dating back to his win at THE NORTHERN TRUST

Miscellaneous Notes

- **Cameron Champ** birdied Nos. 12-16, his first career birdie streak of five holes or more
- **Abraham Ancer's** 36-hole score of 132 is career-low (previous: 133/twice; most recent: 2018 Wyndham Championship)
- **Jordan Spieth** (T8) has opened with two scores of 68 or better for the first time since the 2018 Houston Open (finished T3) and his 36-hole score of 134 is his best since 2017 THE NORTHERN TRUST (lost in a playoff)
- **Denny McCarthy** had a stretch of birdie-eagle-birdie-birdie on holes 15-18, the best birdie/eagle streak of his career (previous: two holes, 2018 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am/R2)
- When play was suspended Friday evening, rookie **Kyle Jones** was 2-under and had a 12-foot eagle putt at his last hole (No. 9); two-putted for birdie Saturday morning to make the cut
- **Davis Love III** (5-under 137) made his 21st cut at the event (24th start) and 566th of his PGA TOUR career (760th start)
