The Bear Trap accounts for 18% of all bogeys, 33% of all doubles, and 38% of all triples or worse at PGA National Champion Course.

The field is a combined +3,489 over par on holes 15 thru 17 since 2007 (+4,629 on all other holes).

**1,310** Balls in the Water: Since 2007, there have been 1,310 balls in the water on the 3-hole stretch of the Bear Trap. 511 different players have played at least 1 competitive round on the Bear Trap in the Honda Classic.

**78%:** Since 2007, 397 of 511 (78%) players have hit at least one ball in the water on the Bear Trap.

**114:** There are currently 114 players that have played the Bear Trap at least once in competition without hitting a ball in the water. However, 13 of those players have played right or more rounds at PGA National (listed to the left).

2013 Honda Classic champion Michael Thompson currently has the most rounds played (24) without recording a ball in the water on the Bear Trap.

In his career on the Bear Trap, he's made 20 pars, three bogeys and one double bogey or worse on this three-hole stretch. Peter Malnati, Eric Axley & Robert Gamez hold the record for most rounds played without recording a birdie on this 3-hole stretch (8 rds).

**-6 on the Bear Trap:** No one (of players with at least 5 competitive rounds) has a better history on holes 15 thru 17 than Russell Knox & Adam Hadwin (-6) since 2007.

**5.7%:** Since 2007, 511 different players have at least one competitive round on PGA National during the Honda Classic. Just 29 of these players are under par for their careers on these three holes (5.7% of all players).
