Things to Know

- Ryan Moore posts his lowest round at Muirfield Village
- Jordan Spieth shoots par-or-better in the opening round at this event for the sixth time in seven starts
- Spieth sits one stroke off the 18-hole lead for the second week in a row
- Tiger Woods birdied three of his last five holes to shoot 2-under 70 and sit T23
- Defending champion Bryson DeChambeau sits T78 after an opening-round 74

- Bogey-free 7-under 65 included 4 consecutive birdies (Nos. 4-7) and marks his low round at Muirfield Village (49 rounds)
- Making 14th consecutive appearance at this event with eight top-25 finishes, including three top-10s (2nd/2007, T10/2008, T5/2010)
- Held 18-hole lead/co-lead eight times, going on to win two of previous seven (2012 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open, 2013 CIMB Classic). Most recent 18-hole lead/co-lead was 2017 WGC-Mexico Championship (T28)

- Part of three-man playoff at season-opening Safeway Open, defeated by Kevin Tway after Brandt Snedeker was eliminated early
- Entered this week ranked No. 3 in Driving Accuracy (72.35%) and hit 13/14 fairways in first round

Jordan Spieth (66/2nd)

- Starting at No. 10 tee, carded five birdies (Nos. 11, 14, 15, 18, 3), an eagle (No. 5) and a bogey (No. 8) en route to a 6-under 66
- Making seventh appearance at the Memorial Tournament with best finish T3 in 2015
- Thursday's 66 marks sixth time in seven starts he's shot par-or-better in the opening round at Muirfield Village (66-75-66-70-68-69-72)
- Comes to the Memorial Tournament off back-to-back top-10 results (T3/PGA Championship, T8/Charles Schwab Challenge). Last time he posted three consecutive top-10s in the same season was the last three FedExCup Playoffs events in 2017 (2nd/Dell Technologies Championship, T7/BMW Championship, T7/TOUR Championship)

Additional Player Notes

- **Bud Cauley**, making his sixth appearance at the Memorial Tournament, advanced to the weekend the first four times (T52/2012, T34/2013, T38/2016, T25/2017). In 2018, he missed the cut before suffering injuries in a car accident on Friday night, causing him to miss the remainder of the season. Played 17 previous events this season posting one top-10 (T10/Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- Two players who were members of the 2017 Presidents Cup International Team – Australia's **Marc Leishman** (No. 1) and India's **Anirban Lahiri** (No. 196) – sit T3 while seeking to improve their points totals on the International Team standings with good performances this week
- Former PLAYERS champion and two-time major winner **Martin Kaymer** birdied four of his last five holes en route to 5-under 67 and sits T3 in his second appearance at this event (T53/2009)
- **Vaughn Taylor**'s 67 marks his best round at Muirfield Village (25 rounds) and the first time he's notched a sub-70 opening round at this event
- Five-time Memorial Tournament champion **Tiger Woods** (70/T23) posted an opening round in the 70s for the sixth-consecutive time at this event. The last time Woods won at Muirfield Village (2012) he also opened with a 2-under 70
- **Rickie Fowler** (69/T12) has two runner-up finishes at this event (2nd/2010, T2/2017)
- Currently No. 4 in the International Team Presidents Cup standings, China's **Haotong Li** (69/T12) is making his first appearance at the Memorial Tournament. Li has made 22 cuts in 30 starts on PGA TOUR, posting three top-10s, most recently T9/2019 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play
- **Phil Mickelson** opens with 2-under 70 while seeking to become the first left-hander to win the Memorial Tournament. Mike Weir's T2 in 2008 is the best finish by a left-hander at this event
- **Sam Burns** and **Ernie Els** withdrew after the first round, both with back injuries
