Things To Know

- The final 30 players from the FedExCup standings teed it up this week for a chance at the ultimate season-long prize, the FedExCup
- New this year, the TOUR Championship, instituted a strokes-based system, FedExCup Starting Strokes, to determine the FedExCup champion. The FedExCup leader heading to the TOUR Championship began the event at 10-under, second place at 8-under, third 7-under, fourth 6-under and fifth at 5-under. Players ranked 6-10 started at 4-under, 11-15 at 3-under, 16-20 at 2-under, 21-25 at 1-under and 26-30 at even par.
- Xander Schauffele made the biggest jump in the standings from T6 to T1 with an opening-round 64 to move to 10-under-par.
- Brooks Koepka (-3) and Justin Thomas (Even) are tied with Schauffele at 10-under-par

First-Round Lead Notes

Largest come-from-behind leads in TOUR Championship during the FedExCup era following round 1

- 2008 Camilo Villegas was eights strokes off the lead after round 1 before topping Sergio Garcia in a playoff
- 2009 Phil Mickelson was seven strokes off the lead after round 1 before winning by three strokes over Tiger Woods 13 of 32 First-round leaders/co-leaders at the TOUR Championship to go to win (most recent: Tiger Woods, 2018))
- First-round leaders/co-leaders to win on PGA TOUR in 2018-19 (most recent: Justin Thomas/BMW Championship)

- Hit 8 of 14 fairways and 15 of 18 greens and took 27 putts
- With his opening-round 64, Xander Schauffele now has a scoring average 67.44 which ranks the lowest of any player in TOUR Championship history with a minimum of 8 career rounds
- The 2017 TOUR Championship winner has shot under par at East Lake Golf Club in 8 of the 9 rounds he has played
- Has reached the TOUR Championship in his first three seasons on the PGA TOUR; only rookie to win at East Lake (2017)
- Has two wins the season at the World Golf Championships-HSBC Champions and the Sentry Tournament of Champions
- Shot one of two bogey-free rounds on Thursday along with Bryson DeChambeau
- Marks the first time Schauffele has held or shared the lead after the opening round of an event

- Hit 6 of 14 fairways, 14 of 18 greens and 28 putts
- The only player of the top four in the FedExCup standings entering the week to shoot under par on Thursday. Justin Thomas (1st), Patrick Cantlay (2nd) and Patrick Reed (4th) all shot even-par in the first round
- Has led or shared the lead through 18 holes on five previous occasions on the PGA TOUR in his career and gone on to win
 once at the 2019 PGA Championship
- Reigning PGA TOUR Player of the Year entered the week at No. 3 in the FedExCup standings and leads the TOUR with three victories this season at THE CJ CUP AT NINE BRIDGES, the PGA Championship and the World Golf Championships-FedEx St. Jude Invitational.
- Best finish in the FedExCup standings in his career came last season when he finished 9th

- Hit 6 of 14 fairways, 10 of 18 greens in regulation with 27 putts
- Thomas has shot 70 or better in 12 of 13 rounds at East Lake Golf Club in his career, with three top-7s in three appearances at the TOUR Championship (T7 /2018, 2nd/2017, T6/2016)

- In six prior tries holding the 18-hole lead/co-lead, Thomas has converted four times including the BMW Championship last week
- Ranked 29th in Strokes Gained: Approach The Green in the first round (-3.028)
- Opened with a first-round 67 at the 2017 TOUR Championship en route to his 2017 FedExCup victory
- With a victory, can join Tiger Woods as the second player to win the FedExCup more than once

Rory McIlroy

- Led the field in Driving Distance (317.7 yards) and hit 15/18 greens in round one
- The 2016 FedExCup and TOUR Championship winner is one off the lead after round 1 in his effort to join Tiger Woods as the second player to win the FedExCup more than once
- Has finished inside the top 10 in four of five starts at East Lake
- Has averaged 4.35 birdies/eagles per round at the TOUR Championship since 2010, the best of any player in that span
 with at least 12 rounds played. Converted five birdies in round one
- In his two victories this season through 18 holes, was two shots off the lead at THE PLAYERS Championship (T5) and four shots behind at the RBC Canadian Open (T25) en route to victories in both events this season.

Rookies in the FedExCup Playoffs

Eight PGA TOUR rookies advanced to the FedExCup Playoffs to earn their first start at THE NORTHERN TRUST. Only Sungjae Im was successful in reaching the TOUR Championship. Im collected seven top-10s in 33 starts and entered the FedExCup Playoffs at 23rd. Here's a look at his progress through the Playoffs:
