

2019 Travelers Championship Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



ShotLink Keys to Victory for Bubba Watson

Bubba Watson won his third Travelers Championship (2010, 2015, 2018) and his 12th career PGA TOUR title at the age of 39 years, 7 months, 19 days. Watson collected 500 FedExCup points moving from 10th to third in the FedExCup standings. With his win, Bubba Watson (3 wins) joined Billy Casper (4 wins) as the only two players to win the Travelers Champions three or more times.

78% of Watson's total strokes gained for the week were a result of his tee-to-green performance, gaining +2.879 strokes per round in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green.

Bubba Watson marked the fourth Travelers Championship (3 players) to come from six or more strokes back entering the final round to win. Bubba Watson has come-from-behind to win in seven of 11 PGA TOUR stroke-play victories (63.6%). Since 2010, Watson is one of three players (Rory McIlroy & Dustin Johnson) that have won seven or more TOUR events in come-from-behind fashion entering the final round (72-hole stroke-play events).

In 2017, Jordan Spieth was sensational around the greens en route to victory at TPC River Highlands, outperforming the field by +1.506 strokes per round in SG: Around-the-Greens (2nd). Spieth's performance in SG: Around-the-Green at the 2017 Travelers Championship marked his fourth-best in his PGA TOUR career and Spieth is the only player to gain over a stroke and half in four TOUR events since the start of the 2013 season (4 measured rounds by ShotLink).

Phil Mickelson

Phil Mickelson (2001 & 2002 Travelers champion) is set to make his sixth start at the Travelers Championship and first start at this event since 2003. Mickelson is the only back-to-back Travelers Championship winner in tournament history. In Mickelson's victories at the Travelers Championship (2001 & 2002), Phil was a combined 30-under par, nine shots better than the next best player (Billy Andrade, -21).

This season, Patrick Cantlay ranks fourth on TOUR in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green, outperforming the TOUR by +1.729 strokes per round and ranks third in Total Strokes Gained, outperforming the TOUR by +2.223 per round.

Cantlay is the only player who currently ranks inside the top-25 in all six Strokes Gained categories.
