Things to Know

- Si Woo Kim makes 106 feet of putts en route to 6-under 66
- San Antonio resident Abraham Ancer offsets even-par front nine with a 5-under 31 on the inward half
- Despite fighting a fever and allergies, Jhonattan Vegas opens with 67
- In his first start at the Valero Texas Open, Rickie Fowler opens with 68
- 2015 Valero Texas Open runner-up Jordan Spieth opens with a 4-under 68 in fifth Valero Texas Open start

First-Round Lead Notes

- Through 22 events this season, five first-round leaders/co-leaders have gone on to win, most recently being J.B. Holmes at the Genesis Open
- Since 2000, only Justin Leonard (2000) and Robert Gamez (2005) have converted a first-round lead/colead into a win at the Valero Texas Open
- At last year's Valero Texas Open, Grayson Murray led by a shot with a 5-under 67, before finishing T16

- Made seven birdies in a nine-hole stretch (Nos. 17, 18, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7) en route to a 6-under 66
- Made 105' 10" of putts in round one
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Total (5.399)
- Takes his first 18-hole lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR

- Making his fourth consecutive start at the Valero Texas Open; T45/2018, T22/2017, MC/2016
- Is making his 14th start of the 2018-19 season, highlighted by three top-10 finishes; T10/CIMB Classic, T4/AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, 3rd/Genesis Open
- In search of his third career PGA TOUR win and first since the 2017 PLAYERS Championship

Abraham Ancer (T2/-5)

- San Antonio resident followed an even-par front with birdies at Nos. 10, 11, 14, 17 and 18, good for a 31 on the inward nine
- Is making his third start in the Valero Texas Open; T42/2016, T58/2018
- Is making his 14th start on the PGA TOUR this season, having finished inside the top 10 at the CIMB Classic (T5) and Shriners Hospitals for Children Open (T4)
- In his last two starts before this week, finished T12 at THE PLAYERS Championship and T17 at last week's World Golf Championships-Dell Match Play
- Claimed five top-10 finishes last season on TOUR en route to a 60th-place finish in the FedExCup
- Remains in search of his first career TOUR win in his 64th start this week
- Has never finished better than T4 (two occasions)

J.T. Poston (T2/-5)

- Made six birdies against one bogey to open his third Valero Texas Open with a 5-under 67
- Finished T27 in 2017 and T30 in 2018 at TPC San Antonio
- Lone top-10 finish in 14 starts this season is T7 at the Desert Classic
- Made a return to the PGA TOUR this season by virtue of his 117th-place finish in the 2018 FedExCup
- Remains in search of his first TOUR title in his 65th start this week

Miscellaneous Notes

- Despite nearly withdrawing from the event Wednesday due to a fever and allergies, Jhonattan Vegas opened with a 5-under 67
- Graeme McDowell, winner of last week's Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship, opened with a bogey-free, 3-under 69
- A week removed from his T2 finish at the Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship, Houston resident Chris Stroud offset one bogey with five birdies to open with a 4-under 68 in his 12th start in the Valero Texas Open (withdrew after last year's first round with a neck injury)
- Nearby Boerne, Texas resident and 2015 Valero Texas Open winner Jimmy Walker opened with a 2-under
 70
- 2018 first-round leader (67) Grayson Murray withdrew during round one with a back injury
- D.A. Points withdrew following his first round with a neck injury
