

## 2019 World Golf Championships-FedEx St. Jude Invitational Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



### ShotLink Keys to Victory for Justin Thomas

Justin Thomas recorded his ninth PGA TOUR win in his 112th career start and eighth win in his previous 43 (19%) starts on TOUR. With his win at the 2018 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational, Justin Thomas became the third player with three wins on TOUR last season (Bubba Watson & Dustin Johnson) and had converted six of eight 54-hole leads/co-leads into victories on TOUR (75%) at the time.

84% of Justin's total strokes gained for the week were a result of his approach the green and putting performance gaining +3.09 strokes per round in these two categories combined.

#### Approach-the-Green vs. The Field 2018 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational

Justin Thomas hit 75.0% (54 of 72) of the greens in regulation, hitting 13 or more greens in each round this week (T2). Thomas averaged 25' 2" in proximity to the hole on all approach shots, 6' 2" closer than the field average (31' 4").

From the 125 to 150-yard range, Justin Thomas ranked fifth in the field averaging 11' 7" in proximity to the hole. For the week, Justin Thomas was dialed in with his wedge play. From inside 150 yards, Thomas was a combined 11-under par and outperformed the field by +7.31 total strokes on 32 approach shots.

## Course & Hole Statistics TPC Southwind

Since 2003, TPC Southwind has surrendered 5,544 balls in the water, marking the most of any course on TOUR. 11 of the 18 holes at TPC Southwind account for all the balls in the water at this course since 2003. From 2003 to last season, the 12<sup>th</sup> hole at TPC Southwind has produced 954 total balls in the water, marking the most of any hole at this course and the second-most of any hole on TOUR in this timeframe.

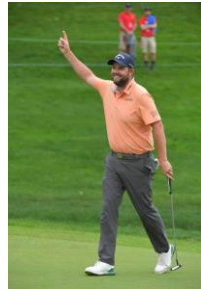

With his T4 finish at last week's Open Championship, Brooks Koepka overtook Matt Kuchar for the #1 position in the FedExCup standings, marking the first time the six-time PGA TOUR winner has led after any week in the standings and the 59<sup>th</sup> player to lead for at least one week in the FedExCup era.

This season, Gary Woodland currently ranks fifth in the FedExCup standings and is one of two players (Marc Leishman) who have spent 35 of 36 weeks ranked inside the top 30 of the FedExCup, marking the most weeks ranked inside the top 30.

#### Matt Kuchar

Matt Kuchar currently ranks second in the FedExCup standings on the strength of two wins, eight top 10s and 12 top-25 finishes. This season, Kuchar leads the TOUR in Round One Scoring Average (68.24) and has the best First 2 Round stroke average (68.50) of any player (min 12 rds).

Last season, Matt Kuchar ranked T119 on TOUR in Par 5 Scoring Average and ranks second on TOUR this season with a stroke average of 4.47. Kuchar has made the fourth biggest improvement in Par 5 Scoring Average ranks of any player from last season.

Matt Kuchar's cumulative score to par in the first 2 rounds is 92-under, 13 strokes better than the next best player (Sungjae Im, -79).

This season, 22 of Kuchar's 34 opening two rounds have been in the 60s (65%).

2018 FedExCup champion Justin Rose currently ranks 11<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings on the strength of one win (Farmers Insurance Open), six top 10s and eight top-25 finishes. Entering this week, Rose is two points behind Jon Rahm for 10<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings, marking the second smallest difference between 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings with two weeks left in the regular season since 2009.

Since the 2019 AT&T Byron Nelson, Jordan Spieth has moved 81 positions in the FedExCup standings from 150<sup>th</sup> to 69<sup>th</sup>, marking the fifth biggest improvement in the standings in this timeframe.

This season, Jordan Spieth has second in Round 2 Scoring Average with a 68.39 stroke average and 197<sup>th</sup> in Final Round Scoring Average (73.36). Spieth leads the TOUR in Putts Per Round in the first 2 rounds compared to 121<sup>st</sup> in Putts Per Round - Round 3 and T114 in Putts Per Round – Round 4.

Rory Mcllroy is coming off his 22<sup>nd</sup> career missed cut on the PGA TOUR at last week's The Open Championship. In Rory's career he has won three times in his next TOUR start following a missed cut in the previous event (Wins: 2019 RBC Canadian Open, 2018 Arnold Palmer Invitational & 2010 Wells Fargo Championship)

Rory Mcllroy currently ranks third in the FedExCup standings on the strength of two wins (THE PLAYERS & RBC Canadian Open), 11 top 10s and 12 top-25 finishes.

### Brooks Koepka

With his T4 finish at last week's Open Championship, Brooks Koepka moved to #1 in the FedExCup standings, marking his first time to lead in the standings of his career and the 59<sup>th</sup> player to rank No. 1 in the FedExCup since 2007. Brooks Koepka is set to make his fifth start at the WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational and has two top 10 finishes in his four previous starts at this event.

### Jason Day

Jason Day is set to make his 10<sup>th</sup> start at the WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational and 250<sup>th</sup> career start on TOUR. Jason Day currently ranks 37<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings on the strength of six top 10s and 11 top-25 finishes.

Since the start of the wrap-around schedule (2013-14) Jason Day has ranked outside the top 30 of the FedExCup entering week #37 in two of the last five seasons. In both of these seasons, Day advanced to the TOUR Championship.

### Jon Rahm

Jon Rahm is set to make his 11<sup>th</sup> start in a World Golf Championship event. Rahm is one of two players (Henrik Stenson) to have two top-three finishes without a win since 2017. Rahm currently ranks 10<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings for the first time since week #28 eight weeks ago.
