### ShotLink Keys to Victory for Brandt Snedeker

Brandt Snedeker recorded his ninth PGA TOUR win in his 306<sup>th</sup> career start on TOUR. Snedeker captured his second Wyndham Championship title. The 2012 FedExCup Champion earned 500 FedExCup points and moved from 80<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings. At 37 years old, Brandt Snedeker owns the 25<sup>th</sup> win by a player in his 30s last season. Brandt lead after every round becoming the second wire-to-wire winner (Brice Garnett at Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship) last season.

**54%** of Brandt's total strokes gained for the week were a result of his approach the green performance en route to victory.

Brandt Snedeker opened the Wyndham Championship recording the 10<sup>th</sup> sub-60 round on the PGA TOUR and became the fifth winner on TOUR to shoot a sub-60 round and go onto win.

At the Wyndham Championship, Snedeker was nearly two shots better per round in SG: Approach-the-Green and averaged over 10 feet closer on approach shots from the fairway.

# Course & Hole Statistics Sedgefield CC

Last season, the field hit 74.25% of the greens in regulation at Sedgefield CC, marking the fourth easiest greens to hit on TOUR. From inside 125 yards, Sedgefield CC was the only course where over 90% of the field hit the green (90.27%). Players averaged 26' 7" in Proximity to the Hole from the fairway, marking the third closest Fairway Proximity average of any a course.

Making the FedExCup Playoffs Every Season: 10 players have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in each of the first 12 seasons of the FedExCup. Entering this week, nine of those players are currently ranked inside the top 125 and four are currently inside the top 30 of the standings.

Four of the 10 players to qualify for the Playoffs every year are in the field this week (Charles Howell III, Brandt Snedeker, Charley Hoffman and Zach Johnson).

Zach Johnson is the only player who has qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in all 12 seasons currently outside the top 125 in the standings entering the Wyndham Championship.

Since 2007, five of the 12 winners at the Wyndham Championship have advanced to the TOUR Championship with 2011 champion Webb Simpson finishing second in the final season standings, marking the best FedExCup finish by a winner at the Wyndham Championship.

Since 2009, the lowest ranked player in the FedExCup to move inside the top 125 at the Wyndham Championship was Davis Love III in 2015 who moved from 186<sup>th</sup> to 76<sup>th</sup> with his victory in Greensboro.

**Last Season:** Nick Taylor & Harris English were the only two players who played their way into the top 125 at the Wyndham Championship. They finished 123<sup>rd</sup> and 125<sup>th</sup> respectively in the final FedExCup standings.

**2018:** Four players played their way into the playoffs at the Wyndham Championship including **J.J. Henry** who accomplished this feat for the second time in his career (2008).

**2016:** 2 players advanced from outside the top 125 at the Wyndham Championship (K. Stanley & S. Stefani).

**2015:** 5 players advanced from outside the top 125 at the Wyndham Championship tying the record at this event under the current points structure.

### Biggest Move in Wyndham History:

With his win at the '15 Wyndham Davis Love III moved from 186<sup>th</sup> to 76<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings (110 spots) marking the largest move up the standings in tournament history. Love III is the first player to move more than 100 spots in the standings at the Wyndham Championship.

The furthest any player has gone starting the Wyndham Championship outside the cut line since 2009 is **Ernie Els** in 2011. Els started the Wyndham Championship ranked 126<sup>th</sup> in the standings and went onto finish 67<sup>th</sup> in the standings in 2011.



**13 First Time Winners This Season:** Entering the 2019 Wyndham Championship there have been 13 First-Time winners on the PGA TOUR this season, marking the eighth season (since 1970) with 13 or more First-Time winners in a season and first since the 2015-16 season (16 First-Time Winners). The average number of starts needed for a player to win their first TOUR title this season is 45.6 and is on pace to be the fewest average number of starts needed by First-Time winners in a season since 1970.

### Paul Casey - 8th in FedExCup

Paul Casey currently ranks eighth in the FedExCup standings and in the Wyndham Rewards Top 10 and can move as high as fourth (\$1.1 million prize) with a win at the Wyndham Championship. Casey is set to make his first start at this event since 2015 when he finished T3.
