Things to Know

- J.T. Poston becomes first player since 1974 to win a stroke-play event without a bogey
- Equaling the lowest final-round score by a winner at the event, Poston picks up first TOUR victory in his 77th career start
- Webb Simpson picks up 10th runner-up finish of his career, including the 2018 and 2019 Wyndham Championships
- Simpson's runner-up finish, his third in his last five starts, earns a spot in the final Wyndham Rewards Top 10
- Players moving into the Top 125 to qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs: Patton Kizzire, Andrew Landry
- Players falling out of the Top 125 in the FedExCup: Robert Streb, Alex Noren
- Brooks Koepka wins the top prize in the Wyndham Rewards Top 10 (\$2 million) and Aon Risk Reward Challenge (\$1 million)

Wins (1): 2019 Wyndham Championship

Best 2018-19 results: Won/Wyndham Championship, T6/RBC Heritage, T7/Desert Classic

- Picks up his first PGA TOUR victory in his 77th start at the age of 26 years, 2 months, 3 days
- Notches the seventh win (fifth player) of the event by a native of North Carolina, joining Raymond Floyd (1979), Davis Love III (1992, 2006, 2015), Scott Hoch (2001), Webb Simpson (2011)
- Equaled Davis Love III (1992) for the lowest final-round score by a winner at the event (62)
- Prior to winning, best finish on TOUR was T4 at the 2017 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open
- Becomes first player since Lee Trevino (1974 Zurich Classic of New Orleans) to win without a bogey in a 72-hole stroke-play event; Note: Jonas Blixt and Cameron Smith won the 2017 Zurich Classic of New Orleans (team format) without a bogey
- Moves from No. 83 to No. 27 in the FedExCup standings; here's a look at his FedExCup standings the last two seasons (117/2018, 132/2017)
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Tee To Green (+10.455), Strokes Gained: Approach The Green (+6.821), Scrambling (10/10; T1), Putts/GIR (T1)
- Won in his third start at the Wyndham Championship (Won/2019, MC/2018, T50/2017)

Webb Simpson (2nd/-21)

- Picks up the 10th runner-up finish of his career, including the 2018 and 2019 Wyndham Championships
- Three runner-up finishes this season have come in his last five starts (RBC Canadian Open, WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational, Wyndham Championship)
- Moves from No. 13 to No. 9 in the FedExCup, the only player to play their way into the final Wyndham Rewards Top 10; also moved into the top 10 at the 2018 Wyndham Championship (from No. 12 to No. 7)
- Made his 11th consecutive start in the event, with top-3 finishes the last three starts (3rd/2017, T2/2018, 2nd/2019)

Additional Player Notes

- After holding at least a share of the lead each of the first three rounds (including a one-stroke lead entering the final round), **Byeong Hun An** closed with a 3-under 67 to finish solo-third; after no bogeys on his first 68 holes, had two down the stretch (Nos. 15 and 18); fell to 0/3 when carrying the lead/co-lead into the final round on TOUR (2017 Waste Management Phoenix Open/6th, 2018 RBC Canadian Open/T2, 2019 Wyndham Championship/3)
- In his attempt to win to gain membership on the PGA TOUR, **Viktor Hovland** finished solo-fourth to earn ticket to the Korn Ferry Tour Finals
- 2011 champion **Si Woo Kim** finished fifth in his attempt to become the 11th multiple winner of the Wyndham Championship
- **Josh Teater** (T6) wrapped up conditional status for 2019-20, moving from No. 165 to No. 146 in the FedExCup; here's a look at his last three starts on TOUR (T6/Barbasol Championship, T13/Barracuda Championship, T6/Wyndham Championship)
- In his bid to join Sam Snead (1949-50, 1955-56) as players to successfully defend his title, 2007 and 2018 tournament champion **Brandt Snedeker** finished T39
- **Zach Johnson** (T53) will miss the FedExCup Playoffs for the first time, finishing No. 154 in the FedExCup

FedExCup Notes

As the final event in the PGA TOUR Season, the Wyndham Championship offered the final opportunity for players to improve their FedExCup positions heading into the Playoffs, or in some instances, move into the top 125 in the FedExCup standings and qualify for the first Playoffs event, THE NORTHERN TRUST.

Players moving into the Top 125 to advance to the FedExCup Playoffs:

- Patton Kizzire (T13; 129th to 118th)
- Andrew Landry (T19; 132nd to 123rd)

Players falling out of the Top 125 and failing to advance to the FedExCup Playoffs:

- Robert Streb (MC; 124th to 128th)
- Alex Noren (T60; 125th to 129th)

Nine players have advanced to the FedExCup Playoffs in each season since the inception of the FedExCup in 2007 (Charley Hoffman, Charles Howell III, Matt Kuchar, Phil Mickelson, Ryan Moore, Justin Rose, Adam Scott, Brandt Snedeker, Bubba Watson).

Despite missing the cut, Pat Perez finishes No. 125 to earn the final spot in the FedExCup Playoffs, just two points ahead of Richy Werenski (No. 126).

Wyndham Rewards Top 10

The top 10 in the FedExCup after the Wyndham Championship share a \$10 million bonus through the Wyndham Rewards Top 10 program. Here's the final payout:

Aon Risk Reward Challenge

Brooks Koepka officially clinched the inaugural Aon Risk Reward Challenge Sunday and will collect a winner take all \$1 million prize and the coveted Aon trophy. Koepka and Jason Day finished tied atop the Aon Risk Reward Challenge season-long standings, but Koepka won the tie-breaker based on their head to head performances on the Aon Risk Reward Challenge designated holes during the 2018-19 PGA TOUR Season which concluded at the Wyndham Championship. A presentation is scheduled for Wednesday, Aug. 7 at THE NORTHERN TRUST, the opening event of the FedExCup Playoffs.
