Extended forecast – Muggy and unstable conditions can be expected Thursday into the weekend as a cold front stalls across NW North Carolina/Southern Virginia. This front will combine with an upper level trough to produce showers and thunderstorms each day, especially during the afternoon and evening hours. Heavy rainfall will be likely with these storms and could produce 1-2+ inches of rain in a short period of time. Thunderstorm chances may decrease on Sunday as the upper level trough and stalled front weakens over the region.
