#### ROUND 2 INTERVIEW April 27, 2019

# ROGER CHAPMAN DAVID FROST (-11 TR)



## Q. Roger, I'll start with you. Talk a little bit about your round, and kind of some like gusty winds out here, huh?

**ROGER CHAPMAN:** Yeah, I wouldn't want to be playing the Ozarks today. That looks like that would be tough up there with that wind. But very, very tricky around here today. Getting the club selection was very difficult. But we played okay the front nine and we sort of, as the wind got harder and harder, we missed a couple shots out there. But David made a couple of great 2s, especially the one on 18, that was fantastic.

## Q. I was going to say, talk a little bit about that putt that you made there, because the wind was really howling on that green.

**DAVID FROST:** Well, I had three guys that hit ahead of me and they all came up a little bit short and they all hit the same club, so I would have been a fool if I hit the same club. I hit one club more and luckily I hit a good shot. Again, I had the read from the three of them, so it made it a little easier. No, it was nice to finish on that note and put us in a good position for tomorrow.

## Q. How tough (inaudible) does the wind just take all that history away and just make it kind of a guessing game in some ways?

**ROGER CHAPMAN:** Well, you don't know when the gusts are going to come, so I had one on 16 today and it just hit a gust and it came up 20 yards short of the green. You just can't legislate for that. So you've just got to take your medicine.

**DAVID FROST:** It was like when Brad was hitting, it was no wind and all of a sudden Roger hits and there's a huge gust comes up. So I think you need the breaks, too, when you're out here, but it's golf. We want to mess with outdoors, that's what we get.

#### Q. Well, I was going to say you've played on four continents for so long, have you been in anything like this? Does it remind you of anywhere?

**DAVID FROST:** Yeah, yeah, we played a lot of golf in Britain, Scotland. It gets blustery as we call it. You've just got to accept it and be patient and go with the flow. It's the same for everyone.

**ROGER CHAPMAN:** The Senior British Open a couple years ago was probably the worst, at Royal Porthcawl, I ever experienced in my life.

Q. What about tomorrow, because you guys are kind of in position tomorrow. See what happens with everything? And they say maybe the weather will be a little bit less windy, more cloudy. Any thoughts on that?

**DAVID FROST:** We have the experience, we know the golf course, and we've just got to play with confidence, I think.

ROGER CHAPMAN: Just play the conditions, see how you go basically.
