Tom Pernice Jr./ Scott Hoch, 15-under 110 (Top of the Rock)

- Teammates for the first time, Pernice/Hoch made seven birdies en route to a 6-under 48 to lead by three entering the final round.
- Should the team go on to win, they would be just the seventh team in tournament history to win wire-to-wire. The last team to do so was Andy North and Tom Watson in 2008.
- Hoch is looking for his first victory since winning the 2008 Chubb Classic in a playoff (a span of 11 years, 2 months, and 11 days). It is his ninth start at the Bass Pro Shops Legends of Golf at Big Cedar Lodge. He owns three top-10s (best: runner-up 2011 with Kenny Perry).
- Pernice is one of two (Tom Watson) players in the field this week who is a Missouri native. It is Pernice's ninth start at the event. His best finish came in 2014 when he finished T5 with partner Bob Tway.
- Pernice owns five victories in 10 years on Tour and is looking for his first victory since winning the 2016 Invesco QQQ Championship.

Jesper Parnevik / Jeff Maggert, 12-under 113 (Ozarks National)

- Teammates for the second year, Parnevik and Maggert carded nine birdies at Ozarks National en route to recording the day's lowest round.
- The duo finished T10 together last year at the Bass Pro Shops Legends of Golf.
- Parnevik is looking for his second victory on PGA TOUR Champions. He won the 2016 Insperity Invitational.
- Maggert is a five-time PGA TOUR Champions winner who has two top-10s in six starts this season, including T3 at the Hoag Classic. He is currently No. 19 Charles Schwab Cup standings.

Paul Goydos / Kevin Sutherland, 12-under 113 (Ozarks National)

- In their fifth year as teammates at this event, Goydos and Sutherland carded four birdies on the front nine and two on the back in best ball for a 5-under 66 at Ozarks National. The team will enter Sunday T2 at 12-under 113.
- In four starts, the duo has not finished outside the top 20. Their best finish at the event was runner-up in 2016.
- Sutherland is No. 4 in the Charles Schwab Cup, won the Rapisan Systems Classic and has posted four finishes in the top 10.
- Sutherland is looking for his third victory on PGA TOUR Champions, while Goydos is looking for his sixth (last: 2017 3M Championship).

Roger Chapman/ David Frost, 11-under 114 (Top of the Rock)

- In their third start as teammates at this event, Chapman and Frost carded five birdies en route to a 3-under 51 at Top of the Rock. Chapman and Frost enter Sunday in fourth place, four strokes behind the leading team.
- The team finished runner-up by one stroke to Michael Allen and Woody Austin in 2016.
- This is Chapman's first start of 2019. Last year, he made three appearances on PGA TOUR Champions, with Bass Pro Shops Legends of Golf being one of them. His last victory was the 2012 U.S. Senior Open Championship.
- Frost has made six starts this year on Tour, including a top-20 finish at the Oasis Championship. His last victory was the 2015 Rapisan Systems Classic.

Other Notes

- Eight teams are tied for fifth place at 10-under 115:
 - **Olin Browne / Steve Pate**
 - The team carded a bogey-free round with five birdies at Top of the Rock par-3. Browne has made eight starts at the event; his best finish was alongside Pate in 2017 with a T5 finish. Browne ranks No. 1 in the field this year in par-3 birdies or better percentage (19.44%) claiming 14 birdies or better on 72 par-3 holes in 18 rounds this year.
 - **Brandt Jobe / Scott McCarron**
 - UCLA teammates Jobe and McCarron carded nine birdies en route to an 8-under 63 at Ozarks National. The team posted their first top-10 finish at the event last year (T9). McCarron entered the week off his ninth PGA TOUR Champions victory (Mitsubishi Electric Classic).
 - **Bart Bryant / Brad Bryant**
 - Teamed together for the fourth time, brothers Bart and Brad Bryant birdied four holes at the Top of the Rock par-3 course en route to a 3-under 51.
 - **Vijay Singh / Carlos Franco**
 - Winners of the 2017 Bass Pro Shops Legends of Golf at Big Cedar Lodge, Singh and Franco carded consecutive birdies on Nos. 5 through 9 en route to an 8-under 63 at Ozarks National.
 - **Michael Allen / John Daly**
 - The team carded birdies on Nos. 1-3 and 5-7 en route to a 6-under 65 in best ball on Ozarks National. Allen and Daly finished T5 last year.
 - **Ken Tanigawa / Gene Sauers**
 - Teammates for the first time, Tanigawa and Sauers carded a 2-under 69 at Ozarks National to add to their 8-under 46 at Top of the Rock. Tanigawa is making his tournament debut, while Sauers is making his third appearance. He finished runner-up in 2013 with Kenny Perry.
 - **Billy Andrade / Joe Durant**

- 2015 champions of the Bass Pro Shops Legends of Golf at Big Cedar Lodge, Andrade and Durant carded a bogey-free 6-under 65 at Ozarks National to enter Sunday T5.
- **Shaun Micheel / Loren Roberts**
 - Teamed together for the first time, Micheel and Roberts carded a 2-under 52 on Top of the Rock to add to their 8-under 63 at Ozarks National on Friday.
- The field includes nine members of the World Golf Hall of Fame:
