

DAVID TOMS (-12)

DAVID TOMS: It was pretty windy when we first started. To start off that way, it was three good shots.

Q. How long was the putt?

DAVID TOMS: It was about 25 feet or so, so it was nice. I think I used up all my putts for the day on the first hole. It was good, a good way to start.

Q. Well, you catch him and then you look up and he birdies five of the first seven.

DAVID TOMS: I remember looking up at the board early just to kind of see because I got off obviously to a good start. It was kind of deflating really. When you start two shots back, you get off to a good start and then all of a sudden you're four shots back not very far into the round.

So I pressed him on the front being aggressive and I was lucky. I turned at 3 under, so that was good. Then had a real short putt at 10 and missed that one. Took the wind out of my sails, I guess, for any hope on the back nine and then missed a couple other short ones.

Ended up having a decent tournament, but probably not as good as how I felt like I played and the opportunities that I had to have a really good week. Disappointing, but another good week here in Boca, really enjoyed it. The last couple years I played really solid and I think I can improve on it next year.

Q. Is it possible at all he can be underrated with what he does?

DAVID TOMS: Who?

Q. Bernhard.

DAVID TOMS: No. Underrated to who? Out here to the players, no. You see what he's doing and you see how he played on this golf course today in the conditions that we played. I mean, that stuff competes on the PGA TOUR in my opinion. It's unfortunate that he's not playing out there, that we have to try and beat him.

Q. Nobody had ever won more than three tournaments after 60. Now that's six for him on this tour.

DAVID TOMS: I don't think anybody -- I mean, if you look at the players out here and you

see the way he works and his fitness and everything else, we don't feel like he's 60 years old and he probably doesn't, either. I think that's just a number because he certainly plays like he's a 50-year-old.
