MIGUEL ÁNGEL JIMÉNEZ: He have no confidence in me. I hit a hook in my driver nearly out of bounds there, I had to put it out in the fairway, to the green, start with bogey. I can see his face. His face, oh, my God. But struggled on the second hole, struggled on the third hole, still managed to make pars. Then I start to make birdies.

Q. Are you going to be aggressive the rest of the week and just nothing to lose, everything to gain?

MIGUEL ÁNGEL JIMÉNEZ: Of course, yeah, of course. Play my game, play my game. My game is probably aggressive, yeah, the way I like to focus on the golf course. But we'll see. What happen, happen. I hope it's close, I hole putts, that way you need to make it under par.
