Q. You laid up to the right part of the fairway on 18, and then --

BERNHARD LANGER: No, I didn't lay up correct. I hit my bunker shot fat. I was hoping to get a lot closer with the sand wedge. And I was caught between a 9-iron and a wedge, and used the 9-iron and pushed it.

Q. Other than that, you made a lot of good -- good short game, a lot of good up-and-downs today.

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah. I'm putting well, which is key. I'm not quite totally happy with my ball-striking, but if I get my ball-striking sorted out, I feel I can really put a charge on, because my short game is good.

Q. And you're in the final group with the guy you're chasing.

BERNHARD LANGER: I haven't even looked yet.

Q. You are.

BERNHARD LANGER: Like a horse race, so --

Q. Yeah. Does that help being in the same group with the guy you're chasing?

BERNHARD LANGER: Really doesn't matter, because I got to play -- I got to shoot low and play as good as I can, but it helps to be in the last group, the second to last group, where you know what you got to do. Certainly on Sunday. Today it doesn't matter, tomorrow it doesn't really matter.
