JOE DURANT (-13)

Q. So great 65 today.

JOE DURANT: Thank you.

Q. You put yourself in a good position to be in the hunt tomorrow. Thoughts on your round today?

JOE DURANT: It was kind of weird. I just had a great about a, what, four-hole, five-hole stretch on the front where I went birdie, eagle, birdie, birdie, and then I kind of just hit the doldrums for a little while, but played solid. Had some good opportunities on the back coming in, I just didn't quite capitalize on some of them. Very happy with how I played the last two days. Obviously going to probably take a low one tomorrow to have a shot at it. Perfect conditions.

Q. And tomorrow will obviously be very competitive, there's a lot of guys in the hunt, not only for the tournament, for the Cup as well, so you'll have to be pretty aggressive?

JOE DURANT: Yeah. I just want to make some money, honestly. Serious, I've got nothing to lose tomorrow so just try to go out and shoot as low as I can and see what happens.

Q. You're in a good spot, though? You don't mind being in the last group? You can almost like let them go ahead of you while you can go ahead of them and kind of make them chase you?

JOE DURANT: Yeah, that might have been a little bit what happened with Jeff today. You know, he played so beautifully the first two rounds and then he's four ahead and he's got Bernhard with him and they could have been kind of isolated. And then Miguel spins a low one, so it can happen, for sure. I know Vijay shot really low I think the last round last year, 61, so it's out there obviously. That's what you try to get your mindset, that you're going to have to make a lot of birdies and just see what happens.
