TOM BYRUM: Made some nice putts today.

Q. Tomorrow will be fun.

TOM BYRUM: Sure will be.

Q. Looking forward to it?

TOM BYRUM: Yeah, yeah. I don't know how I stand.

Q. There are six or seven guys at 10.

TOM BYRUM: Tied for the lead or what?

Q. Either -- Ames is at 11. In any case bunched at the top.

TOM BYRUM: Bunched up everywhere it looked like. All right.

Q. When is the last time on a Sunday you were at the cusp?

TOM BYRUM: Last week.

Q. I didn't remember that.
