

LEE JANZEN (-7)

Q. You're 7-under 66, low round of the day so far. Take me through it.

LEE JANZEN: Well, both days I started on 10 and birdied the 10th hole, and both days ended up entirely different. I don't know that my ball-striking was a whole lot different. I drove the ball well both days. Hit a lot of greens yesterday, and when I wasn't on the green, I was just barely off the green similar to today.

Yesterday afternoon, very frustrated with my putting so I just spent some time on the putting green trying to figure it out. I know my tendencies and I was actually overdoing my correction as it turns out, which is rare. We usually go back to like, okay, here's my bad habit, this is how I fix it. Well, I over-fixed it. I just needed my putter to go straighter back, and I holed four putts today. There was a few that I think if I would have hit a better putt, I might have made also. But it was a good day that I had chances virtually every hole and I capitalized at least a few times.

Q. And an eagle on 2 helped?

LEE JANZEN: Smashed a drive, hit a 5-iron to about five feet and made it.

Q. So obviously different mentality going into tomorrow?

LEE JANZEN: Yes. I would like not to change my mentality because today worked. But yes, now I'm closer. The wind's gotten up here. Most of my round I played without the wind, which was good. And I know 15's into the wind, 16's into the wind and 18's into the wind. I know those holes are going to be a pretty good challenge for the leaders coming in. My guess is I'm not going to be too far off the lead. Somebody might get to double digits.

Q. Perry's at 10 right now.

LEE JANZEN: So, yeah, I don't expect anybody to be 14 or 15 at the end of the day.
