Q. How much, if any, did the wet conditions help you in going for the green today?

MIGUEL ÁNGEL JIMÉNEZ: Well, the wet condition probably helps a little bit I think for people because at least it's softer and you can attack more to the flags, no? We get the benefit of that, yeah.

Q. Are you a scoreboard watcher?

MIGUEL ÁNGEL JIMÉNEZ: Of course. Interesting to see what happening there, of course.

Q. How does that affect you in your play?

MIGUEL ÁNGEL JIMÉNEZ: Well, you know, that show you where you are, what position you are on the golf course, if you need to be more aggressive or less aggressive. But wasn't the (indiscernible) I think is you have to don't get stress with that. You see that, see that information, how you play. I don't think not one don't look at it at the leaderboard, I think we're humans.

Q. Did you figure as well as you were playing at some point you had to be in the lead?

MIGUEL ÁNGEL JIMÉNEZ: When I play today I start making birdies and things and I see my name claiming, climbing up and is good. I feel good all week, especially today, make birdie, hitting to the flag, holing some putts. That's what you needed.

Q. What clicked for you today, Miguel? What worked well?

MIGUEL ÁNGEL JIMÉNEZ: Everything, everything. Even if I missing some fairways, on the edge of the fairways, but we have good shots from the tee. My irons are amazing today to the flag and making nine birdies today and still some of them don't make it, but I play well, solid, and so happy, yeah.

Q. How early in the round did you kind of know you were going to have a good day out there?

MIGUEL ÁNGEL JIMÉNEZ: When I start making birdies, yeah, because I feel good, I feel very calm, I feel nice the way I'm hitting the ball and I start making birdies and I say, well, yesterday (indiscernible) coming to you because you are hitting good and the momentum keep going.

Q. Were you thinking about your position in the Schwab Cup Playoffs at all? This moved you from No. 22 to No. 10, so you go into next week looking pretty good.

MIGUEL ÁNGEL JIMÉNEZ: Jumping, wow, yeah.

Q. So obviously you didn't know that yet?

MIGUEL ÁNGEL JIMÉNEZ: No, no, I didn't know. I know I going to make a jump, but I didn't see. No. 10, okay, that's good. Two more tournament to go and people play very well as you see. McCarron, Kelly, all of them play well and it's going to be tough to win the Schwab Cup, but the last two more tournament we have to play. But I will try to do my best. I will try to play hole by hole, shot by shot, and anything happens. I will fight, I'm a fighter.

Q. How was the whole experience? Your victory aside, golf course, fans, how was the entire experience?

The greens, they are firm at the beginning and very fast, today a little bit softer and a little bit slower than the previous days. A lot of water yesterday, no, but the golf course is amazing. And then now everything is nice, Mondays no like the weekend, no, but still some crowds there and nice to see people coming to the golf course.
