Today – Clouds will be on the increase as the day progresses, however dry conditions will remain in place. Temperatures bottomed out around 36 degrees this morning but will quickly climb towards 60 degrees by the noon hour. Temperatures this afternoon should peak around 64-65 degrees. Southerly winds will develop during the day but are expected to remain less than 10 mph.

Extended Forecast – The remnants of Tropical Storm Nester will lift into the Mid-Atlantic tonight with tropical moisture surging towards Richmond. Rain is expected to develop after midnight and could become heavy, especially between 5-9am. Rain intensity will diminish by the late morning hours and should completely end by 2pm, if not earlier. Confidence in rain timing is high. Most likely rainfall: 1.00-1.50". With that said, there remains some uncertainty with rainfall amounts and it wouldn't take much of a northern shift in the storm to bring 2+ inch rainfall amounts into the Richmond area.
