

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

DAVID TOMS (-8)

Q. So you had another good day today, finished at 8 under.

DAVID TOMS: Yeah, I had a good -- you know, I played well on the back side again today. I struggled on the front getting anything going the first two days, but hung in there. I knew I had some birdie holes on the back, and I made a couple of long putts and that kind of got me going, and then I obviously finished well the last couple holes.

Q. Do you think the scoring was a little bit easier today?

DAVID TOMS: Probably was, yeah. I think you saw that, some low rounds today. I just never could get the ball close to the hole for the start of my round and middle of my round. Didn't really have any makeable putts. I finally hit it a bit closer and made some.

Q. You finished I think 5th last year here, top-10. Is there something in particular that suits you about this course would you say?

DAVID TOMS: I don't know. It's a good golf course, I enjoy it. Kind of old fashioned kind of golf course. I played a pro event here, one of the first events I played as a professional in the Taco Bell, so I've always enjoyed coming to this area. It's a nice spot.
