COLIN MONTGOMERIE (-8)

Q. What was the course like today?

COLIN MONTGOMERIE: It was a long day. We played 32 holes, some of us had to play 36. It's a very long day for us, but at the same time the course has dried out remarkably since this morning. They squeegeed the driving range, it was under water, so they've done a great job. Everyone's done a great job to get us around and back on schedule really. We can finish this tournament in three rounds because we classify this, you know, damn near a major, this event. It really is, it's right up there. If you win in Houston, you know you've done a great job. It's one of the best fields we have on one of the best courses we have, so we look forward to it every year.

Q. You positioned yourself in pretty good shape.

COLIN MONTGOMERIE: Yeah, not bad, not bad. I missed a couple of putts coming in there at 16 and 18, but not too bad. I played well, 68-68, you can't complain around here. That's nothing much wrong with that. So yeah, hey, you give yourself a chance and see what happens, but the guys ahead are obviously playing well and it all depends on who holes the putts tomorrow.
