DAVID TOMS (-16)

Q. Well, that's a tough one. I don't know what else you can say.

DAVID TOMS: Tough? What do you mean tough? The way I finished?

Q. Well, just the whole thing, finishing second.

DAVID TOMS: I mean, I didn't get off to a good start. Came back, was doing great. Hit a lot of good putts on the back nine that I didn't make, and Tom played great. I mean, I told you yesterday standing right here somebody was going to play good today and I had to play really well. I shot, what, 16 under par for the tournament in some pretty tough wind. I felt I played solid.

Certainly hate to end up that way on the last hole, but I wasn't even -- I got over the first spot trying to make it because I figured if I made it, I had a chance to win right there. Never even entered my mind that I was going to three-putt.

But he played great today. I mean, I would have had to play a really solid round to run away with it. I would have had to play a good round to win. I wasn't able to do it.

Q. No. 10, that putt at 10, in hindsight it's easy to say, but if you make that eagle putt at 10, you go up by four. That might have been --

DAVID TOMS: Yeah, I don't know how it didn't go in. I mean, it hit a lot of the hole. Almost went opposite of what I thought it was going to do. That's all you can do.
