Bernhard/Jason Langer, 60-60— 120 (-24)

- After finishing the second round in a three-way tie at 24-under par with Team Goosen and Team Lehman, Jason Langer holed a 15-foot putt for eagle on the first playoff hole (No. 18) to win the 2019 PNC Father Son Challenge
- The victory was Bernhard Langer's fourth at the event in 15 starts, having won back-to-back titles in 2005-06 with his eldest son, Stefan, and with Jason for the first time in 2014
- Bernhard Langer's four titles make him the second most winning player in PNC Father Son Challenge history behind Raymond Floyd (5)

- 19-year-old Jason Langer is currently a sophomore at the University of Pennsylvania where he is a member of the golf team
- World Golf Hall of Fame member Langer owns 40 titles on PGA TOUR Champions, including two in 2019 (Oasis Championship, Senior Open Championship)
- Langer is the all-time money leader (current total: \$28,653,126) on PGA TOUR Champions and has won the money title 10 of the last 12 years.
- The five-time winner of the Charles Schwab Cup had 14 top-10s this season, marking his eighth straight year with 11 or more on Tour

Miscellaneous Notes

- It was the fifth playoff in the PNC Father Son Challenge's 22-year history (2015, 2002, 2000, 1999). It was the second time a playoff was won with an eagle (2015, Lanny/Tucker Wadkins) on the final hole
- Lee Trevino, the only player to compete in all 22 PNC Father Son Challenges, finished T6 at 16-under par with his son, Daniel, his best 36-hole score at the event
- The first female professional to compete in the PNC Father Son Challenge, Annika Sorenstam, a 10-time LPGA major champion, finished T19 at 7-under with her father, Tom
