THINGS TO KNOW:

- Team Goosen posts a 14-under 58 for the second straight round, dating to 2018, to take first-round lead
- Three-time PNC Father Son Challenge winner Bernhard Langer looks for second win with son, Jason, after a 12-under 60
- Team Duval puts together 10 birdies and an eagle in bid for second PNC Father Son Challenge title
- Annika Sorenstam, the first female professional to compete in the PNC Father Son Challenge, opens with a 6-under 66 with father, Tom
- Lee Trevino, the only player to compete in every PNC Father Son Challenge (21 prior to this week), opens with a 9-under 63 with his son, Daniel, in bid for a first win

FIRST-ROUND LEAD NOTES:

14 of 21	First-round leaders/co-leaders at the PNC Father Son Challenge to win, including 10 of last 12
2015, 2018	Only years since 2004 the winners did not lead after the first round (Lanny/Tucker Wadkins, two strokes back in 2015 and Davis/Dru Love, three strokes back in 2018)
2	Largest 18-hole lead (six times, most recent; 2015, Vijay/Qass Singh)
57	18-hole scramble record (Ray/Ray Floyd, Jr. /R2/1995, Bob/David Charles/R1/1998)

Retief/Leo Goosen (58/-14)

- Birdied five of their first six holes and last eight straight en route to a 14-under 58
- Retief and Leo, who is a 16-year-old high school junior, closed with a 58 in last year's event to finish T2
- Team Goosen is making a fourth start in the PNC Father Son Challenge; T2/2016, 8th/2017, T2/2018
- Winner of seven PGA TOUR events, including the 2001 and 2004 U.S. Open
- Collected 12 top-10 finishes in his first season on PGA TOUR Champions in 2019, highlighted by a win at the Bridgestone Senior PLAYERS Championship

Bernhard/Jason Langer (60/-12)

- 2005, 2006 and 2014 winner of the PNC Father Son Challenge, Team Langer put an exclamation point on a round highlighted by 10 birdies with an eagle at the par-5 18th
- Langer won in 2005 and 2006 with son, Stefan, and with Jason in 2016
- Langer is making his 15th consecutive start in the PNC Father Son Challenge
- Langer is the winner of 40 titles on PGA TOUR Champions, two of which he added in 2019 (Oasis Championship, Senior Open Championship)

David/Brady Duval (60/-12)

- In his seventh start in the event, 13-time PGA TOUR winner David Duval partnered with son, Brady, to make 10 birdies and an eagle to open with a 12-under 60
- With son Nick Karavites, won the 2016 event with scores of 61-62—123 (-21)
- Duval is the winner of the 2001 The Open Championship
