JOEY SINDELAR (-5)

Q. You finish at 5 under so you've got a share of the lead. Just your thoughts on today?

JOEY SINDELAR: Well, funny, you know what comes to my mind? I didn't have my A-game. (Laughs.) So I've been hurt, I've had a shoulder blade since Oak Hill, our Senior PGA. The only tournament I've played where I didn't really hurt was the Dick's Sporting Goods and then my back started hurting. I didn't even know if I was going to play the last two or three and certainly didn't know if I was going to be here. So to be here at 5 under and talking to you is a riot.

I hit it okay, certainly good enough, but I made putts. It was a blast to shoot a score. I feel like I'm in the first third of the year, I've played so little golf. To have a day like this on a venue like this, it's really, really special.

Q. And it's always a great week with the juniors. How did yours do today?

JOEY SINDELAR: Awesome. Jasmine, if she isn't the personification of what this is about and what they're trying -- the kind of kids and demeanors they're trying to spit out of this whole thing, she's it. She's a wonderful young lady and she played great, she played really great. She probably helped me. If I shot five, she helped me two or three. A wonderful, kind, beautiful young lady.
