

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW
March 30, 2019



BILLY ANDRADE (-5)

Q. Billy, just overall thoughts on the round? You were able to make your way up the leaderboard a little bit and put yourself in position for the third day.

BILLY ANRADE: Yeah, played great. Really played well on the front nine, I shot 4 under. It could have been 6 or 7 really. Got it going.

This is a hard golf course. You've just got to plug away. I made some nice putts on the front, and then on the back nine I made a nice birdie on 13 and then finished with a bogey here at 18. So I don't have a great taste in my mouth right now, but it's all good.

Looks like Kevin's playing great. This is a tough -- like I said, it's a really hard golf course, so I like it here. I've played well here in the past and I'm looking forward to tomorrow.

Q. I could kind of see the frustration on your face there on 18 with the bogey specifically.

BILLY ANRADE: Well, it's just one of those days where you really could have -- I really could have jumped up the leaderboard. I could have shot an 8 or 9 under today, I played that well. Just didn't make a few putts that I should have made. And then, like I said, bogeying the last hole right from the middle of the fairway was not great. My only bogey of the day. But you've got to play great for three days to win, so my goal is to win golf tournaments and I haven't won in a while, so maybe tomorrow I can get it going again.

Q. Is that -- like you said, you have a bad taste in your mouth from the last hole, but is that enough of a win [sic] for you to be able to put yourself in position on the third day because that's what everyone wants going in?

BILLY ANRADE: Well, we'll wait and see how it all shakes out and see how Kevin comes in and see how many I'm behind, but right now I'm 5 behind. I need maybe a little help from him or the guys ahead of me. Having a chance is what we all want, what we all strive for. Everybody wants to win out here and winning is what it's all about, so hopefully I'll have a chance tomorrow.

Q. Having two runner-up finishes here, does that change your mindset going into tomorrow or do you think you would feel the same no matter how you played in the past here?

BILLY ANRADE: No, I think it's -- I have had a couple of runner-ups, but this is hard. This is probably the hardest golf course we play all year, and when the wind's blowing like this

and the greens are this firm and fast, you can't make mistakes. You can't short-side yourself, it's hard to chip around here. I'm really pleased with where I am right now, but we all want to win, so I would rather be leading instead of being in whatever place I'm in.

Q. What will you do tonight?

BILLY ANRADE: Tonight? I don't know. I'm thinking maybe definitely watch some basketball. Just check in on the Red Sox, make sure they blow out the Mariners. Other than that, have a nice dinner and get a good night's sleep.
